



## VSGA Amateur/State Open of Virginia Qualifier Lake Chesdin Golf Club

## **NOTICE TO PLAYERS**

(This information supplements the Championship entry and the Standard Local Rules and Terms of Competition for 2024 VSGA Championships)

FORMAT/TEE MARKERS: 18-hole stroke play. Play will be from the GOLD tees.

**OUT OF BOUNDS:** In addition to the line between the course-side points, at ground level, of white stakes and fence posts, out of bounds is also defined by this course side edge of all public roads. A ball which comes to rest on or across a public road defined as out of bounds is out of bounds even though it may lie on another part of the course.

**DROPPING ZONES**: If a ball is in or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found in in the penalty area, the player may:

proceed under Rule 17; or as an additional option, drop a ball, under penalty of one stroke, in the Dropping Zone.

Hole #4: In front of forward tee.

Hole #8: At the end of the fairway (right side).

Hole #11: In front of the most forward tee.

**Hole #18:** At the end of the fairway.

TEMPORARY IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS: Model Local Rule F-23 is in effect for greenside fans. Relief procedure may be taken on either side of the TIO.

**SCORING:** The digital scorecard used via the Golf Genius app is the unofficial scorecard. The official scorecard is the paper scorecard which needs to be verified in the scoring area.

CADDIES/TRANSPORTATION: Players may have a caddie and caddies may ride in carts only if there is a seat available. Spectators (outside influences) may ride in carts if there is a seat available.

PACE OF PLAY: Please refer to the VSGA Standard Local Rules, and VSGA.org for the complete pace of play policy.

TIES/PLAYOFF: There are 6 spots available for the VSGA Amateur Championship and 4 spots available for the State Open of Virginia. A sudden death playoff to determine the final spot and three (3) alternate spots for both the VSGA Amateur Championship and State Open of Virginia will be held immediately after the completion of play. If players are not present the winner of the playoff will be decided using a random method.
