FIELD NOTES

- All four two-time Senior Open champions are participating at Willow Oaks, looking to become the first player to win three Senior Opens: Brendan McGrath, Rick Schuller, Dave Pulk, and Buck Brittain.
- Brittain is the only player to win consecutive Senior Open titles, doing so in 2017 and 2018.
- Brittain will look to become just the second player to win VSGA Senior Amateur and Senior Open of Virginia titles in the same year. David Partridge won both in 2011. Brittain defeated Scott Shingler in last month's VSGA Senior Amateur title match, 3 and 1.
- Schuller went nine years between his first and second Senior Open titles.
- In addition to both finalists, another semifinalist from the VSGA Senior Amateur--Pete Barbera--is in the field at Willow Oaks..
- After five years at Independence Golf Club, this event is being staged at Willow Oaks as Independence prepares to host stroke-play qualifying rounds for the upcoming U.S. Mid-Amateur Championship.
- Amateurs won this championship each year from 2017-2020, but a professional has won the title three years in a row.
- Three Willow Oaks members will participate: Steve Serrao, David Jordan, and Mark Lange. Serrao won his second VSGA Senior Stroke Play title earlier this year, and Jordan is a past winner of the VSGA Senior Stroke Play.
- Seven of the top nine players in the VSGA Senior Player rankings are in the field. No. 7 Bowen Sargent and No. 9 Kevin South are not participating.
