FIELD NOTES

Richmond area clubs have dominated this event since it took on its current format in 2014. Hermitage Country Club, led by VSGA Golfer of the Year Sam Beach (pictured) won its record 19th title in 2023, making it seven straight victories for clubs located in greater Richmond. The last non-Richmond winner came in 2015, when Army Navy CC and Cavalier G&YC shared the spoils. The last outright non-Richmond winner was Fredericksburg's Lee's Hill GC in 2013.



- Four clubs are tied for second all-time in wins with four, far behind Hermitage: Army Navy (last title 2015), Hanover GC (2011), Roanoke CC (1975), and Farmington CC (1955).
- The winning four-player Hermitage team returns intact for 2024: Sam Beach, Ben Beach, Jordan Utley and Pete Toole.
- Last year's runner-up team, Independence, returns its three amateurs (Cam Young, Hank Klein, and Scott Bemberis). They'll play with professional Ryan Cole. All Independence amateurs are competing as seniors.
- Lakeside Park Club features Brandon Ramsuer and Brock Kelley, along with John Rosenstock and Chad Jones. Ramsuer and Kelley recently paired to win the Allegheny Amateur, and Ramsuer was on the winning side at the 6th VSGA Multi-Format Team Championship.
- The father-son combo of Chris and Ryan Slonaker are among the competitors for Spotswood Country Club, joined by Chad Seibert and Tod Foshee.
- Four-time State Open of Virginia champion Jay Woodson is among the competitors for the host club, The Foundry.
- Williamsburg Golf Club features two of the event's three female competitors--Brenda Johnson and Jenna Heuser. Shabril Derco is also playing, representing Cedar Point Club.
- Willow Oaks CC, the 2021 champion, features past VSGA Senior Amateur, Senior Four-Ball and Senior Stroke play winner Steve Serrao, along with Tim Dickson, Matt Hedley, and professional Sean Patterson.
- Falling River CC's team features 2019 VSGA Mid-Amateur winner Marshall Tinsley, along with Adam Marshall, Chad Lipscomb, and Michael Tweedy.
