FIELD NOTES

The Junior Match Play swapped spots on the schedule with the Junior Stroke Play because the JSP winner received an exemption into the U.S. Junior Amateur, therefore it had to be played well before that championship, which concluded last weekend. Eight players who finished inside the top 20 at the Junior Stroke Play are in the field at Olde Mill: Ben Cowgill (5th), Joshua Cummins (T6), Dennis McGowan Jr., pictured (T9), Liam Maclauchlan (T9), Shrey Sharma (T14), Luke Libbey (T17), Braden Hermansky (T17) and Charles Lange (T17).



- Anyone advancing to match play this week will earn a spot in the 2025 VSGA Junior Stroke Play Championship (if age eligible).
- There is guaranteed to be a new champion this year as Talon Dingedine is not back to defend his title. The 2023 finalist, Jonathan McEwen, has aged out and is heading into his second year at Washington & Lee University.
- Only three players who made match play last year at Kiln Creek are in the field: Charlie White, Charles Lange, and Noah Maclauchlan. White and Lange were each defeated by a finalist last year, with White falling to McEwen in the round of 16 and Lange coming up short against Dingedine in the quarterfinals. Maclauchlan advanced to the quarterfinals before losing to Grady Williams.
- The youngest player in the field is Chesapeake's Tyler Fink, who turned 14 earlier this month. The oldest player in the field is Richmond's Sam Hahn, who will turn 19 next month.
- There are three sets of brothers in the field: Liam and Noah Maclauchlan, Zuhair and Uzair Mirza, and Luke and Jack Wargo.
- The last time the championship match in this event reached the 18th hole was in 2011 when Adam Ball defeated Chas Bassing in 2011.
- The stroke-play qualifying medalist hasn't won this event since 2015, when Mark Lawrence Jr. was medalist and then defeated Tom Crow in the championship match. In event history, only four players have won after earning medalist honors: Lawrence, Ball, Cameron Yancey, and G.W. Cable.
- Though Olde Mill has hosted a number of invitationals, this is the first true VSGA championship to be played at the Laurel Fork resort.
