

# FIELD NOTES

The Multi-Format Team Championship features two distinct rounds of play.

Monday's opening round is a two-person scramble where both players play from the teeing area, one of the tee shots is selected and both players play their second shots from that spot. One of the second shots is then selected, and both players play their third shots from that spot, and so on until the ball is holed. Scores have been typically low during the opening round, but rise in Tuesday's modified alternate shot round.



- On Tuesday, both players play from the teeing area, one of the tee shots is selected and players alternate shots from there until the ball is holed. Example: Player A's tee shot is selected, player B plays next, then A and so on until the ball is holed.
- Though several players who are competing have been on the winning side of this event are in the field, only one side that is a past champion is participating: Brandon Ramsuer and Ryan Taylor, who won in a playoff at The Dominion Club in 2020. Other past event champions playing include Mikey Moyers (pictured above), who won with Evan Beck in 2021. He'll pair with Kyle Bailey, who partnered with Jeff Long to win the inaugural MFTC in 2019. John Rosenstock, who won in 2022 with Trey Wren, is playing with Brock Kelley. And Ben Beach, who won last year with brother Sam, is playing with fellow Hermitage member and three-time VSGA Amateur finalist Jordan Utley.
- Past VSGA Four-Ball champions Blake Carter and Adam Houck have partnered for the event.
- Past State Open of Virginia champion and former UVA player Jack Montague is in the field, playing with Will MacIlwaine.
- Steve Serrao and Jay Serrao, who won the Senior Multi-Format Team Championship last fall at Lakeside Park Club, are partnering again.
- Another senior side to watch is Virginia Golf Hall of Famer Keith Decker paired with three-time VSGA Senior Four-Ball champion Jon Hurst. The two won the inaugural senior title in this event in 2019.
- As was the case in 2023, the Senior and Super Senior Multi-Format Team championships will be played in the fall at Lakeside Park Club. As the popularity of this championship increased, the move to separate the seniors/super seniors from the open division was a necessary one.
