FIELD NOTES

The U.S. Mid-Amateur Championship is only weeks away, and four VSGA members will warm up for the event at the VSGA

Mid-Amateur Championship. Andrew Crowley, George Ordway, John Rosenstock (pictured), and Jordan Utley qualified for the U.S. Mid-Am and are in the field in Petersburg. All will be seeking their first individual VSGA championship. Other VSGA members participating in the U.S. Mid-Am in Richmond are Bruno Buccolo, Adam Horton, Brinson Paolini, and Evan Beck, who was a U.S. Mid-Am finalist last year.



- Last year's Mid-Am champion, Mikey Moyers, returned to the pro ranks as a teacher, so he's not in the field this year. There are four past champions teeing it up at CCP: Marshall Tinsley (2019), Buck Brittain (2018), Justin Young (2017), and Scott Shingler (2010). Additionally, two past VSGA Amateur winners are in the field: Trey Smith (2018) and Shingler (2011). Brittain defeated Shingler 3 and 1 in last month's VSGA Senior Amateur championship match.
- Four others who reached match play at the VSGA Amateur are playing: Shingler, Jason Spaar, Young, and Joey Jordan.
- Of the players who finished in the top five last year at Elizabeth Manor, only one--Michael Redwood--is in the field this year. The top five finishers at the VSGA Mid-Amateur are exempt from qualifying for the 2025 VSGA Amateur, which will be held at Birdwood Golf at Boar's Head Resort.
- At 58, Scott Huneycutt is the oldest player of the field and is one of 12 seniors (age 50 or older) participating. Caleb Olson, who turned 25 in late July, is the youngest player in the field.
- Carter Smith, known on social media as the DOD King for hitting driver off the deck, is in the field. Find his videos [here](#).
- Ryan Taylor and Brandon Ramsuer, who have paired to win two VSGA Multi-Format Team Championship titles, are in the field.
- The Mid-Amateur is making its first appearance at CCP since 2005, when Keith Decker won by one stroke over Albert Johnson Jr. and Allen Barber with a three-day total of 207. Barber was the Mid-Am winner in 1999 at CCP, as he won by a stroke over David Passerell with a total of 214. David Partridge won the title in 1988, the first time CCP hosted, with a total of 216.
