**FORMAT:** Mid-Senior Amateur is for players ages 60 and older. Super Senior Amateur is for players ages 65 and older, split into three age divisions: 65+, 70+, 75+. One round of stroke-play qualifying. Top 16 advance to match play in Mid-Senior and Super Senior 65+. Top eight advance in 70+ and 75+ Super Senior divisions.

**STARTING TIMES:** Monday: 8:30 a.m. off No. 1. Tuesday: Each division will play morning and afternoon matches. Wednesday: Final matches in the morning in the 70+ and 75+ divisions. Mid-Senior and 65+ will play in morning and afternoon, with the final matches in each coming in the afternoon.

# FIELD NOTES

Since turning 60, Virginia Golf Hall of Famer Keith Decker has owned this event, winning four straight titles. Last year's close call against Bob Bailey marked the only time that Decker played past the 16th hole in any of the championship matches. Decker earned his 35th VSGA title this spring when he paired with Scott Shingler to win the VSGA Senior Four-Ball Championship. This championship is relatively close to Decker's Martinsville home, which should further add to his advantage in the event.



- Bailey is among those set to challenge Decker in the Mid-Senior field. Others to watch include past VSGA Senior Stroke Play and Senior Four-Ball champion Mike Krulich, Jon Zampedro, Paul Townsley (last year's stroke-play qualifying medalist) and John Lombardozi.
- The 65+ division boasts the most entrants. Defending division champion Jack Allara returns, and he's found success in Danville before, winning the Super Senior Stroke Play 65+ title at the club in 2020.
- Allara defeated David Partridge in last year's 65+ title match. Partridge won the Super Senior Stroke Play 65+ title on a blistering hot July day at Loudoun G&CC. He's seeking his first title in this event but is a past winner of the Mid-Senior Amateur.
- Others to watch in the 65+ division include Tim Vigotsky (current VSGA Super Senior player rankings points leader), 2020 champion Jeffrey Flax, past VSGA Senior Amateur winner Tim Kelley, and past VSGA Amateur winner Allen Barb.
- Dayton Slater won the 65+ title in 2018 at Loudoun G&CC but is looking for an improvement on last year's showing in the 70+ division. He reached the final before falling to Robert Gardiner, who is back to defend his age-division title.
- Among those challenging last year's finalists are Jim Woodson, a two-time VSGA Super Senior Four-Ball winner, and Van McCarter, who won the 70+ division in 2021 at Meadowbrook CC.
- Janicki is seeking a repeat in the 75+ division but will have to deal with the usual suspects like George Owens, John Casstevens and Terry Towler. Walter Anderson, the 2021 75+ winner, is in the field, as is Harry Lea, a Danville member who won the Super Senior Stroke Play 75+ title at his home course in 2020.
