



FIELD NOTES

Scott Shingler made his Senior Amateur debut last year at Willow Oaks a

memorable one, outlasting Matt Sughrue in an exciting final match. Shingler became part of a select group of players to win both the VSGA Amateur and VSGA Senior Amateur. The others: Keith Decker, David Partridge, Vinny Giles, and Richard Payne. Shingler continues to play a schedule of both senior and regular events. He made match play at this year's VSGA Amateur, and teamed with Decker to win this year's Senior Four-Ball Championship at Westwood.



- Shingler isn't alone in the past champions club at this year's Senior Amateur. Nine past champs will tee it up at Tuckahoe Creek: Shingler (2023), Jon Hurst (2022), Buck Brittain (2020, 2021), Steve Serrao (2019), Cam Young (2018), Rich Buckner (2017), Keith Decker (2013, 2014, 2016), David Partridge (2011, 2015), and Tim Kelley (2012).
- Additionally, several past finalists are in the event, including Bowen Sargent, David Jordan, Dave Pulk, Duncan Hardcastle, and Rick Bendall, who made the final 18 years ago in 2006.
- Michael Hays is the lone player in the field to have qualified for the U.S. Senior Amateur Championship. VSGA members Roger Newsom and Matt Sughrue are exempt from qualifying but are not competing in the VSGA Senior Amateur.
- The winner of the 2024 VSGA Senior Amateur will be exempt from local qualifying for the 2025 U.S. Senior Open. Much like the U.S. Open and U.S. Amateur, the U.S. Senior Open will go to a two-tier qualifying model starting in 2025.
