FIELD NOTES

Can they do it again? Buck Brittain and Jon Hurst are just the second side in VSGA history to win three straight Senior Four-Balls. Only Virginia Golf Hall of Famers Jim Kite and Bob Moyers have won more consecutive titles, winning five straight from 1991-95. Both Brittain and Hurst are past VSGA Senior Amateur champions. They already have one title this year in a partner event, winning the Alleghany Amateur by a whopping 12 strokes.



- Hurst enters the event ranked No. 1 in the VSGA Senior Player Rankings, carding wins in the Alleghany Amateur and Fredericksburg Amateur and a runner-up finish at the Fox Puss Invitational.
- Brittain finished tied for third at the Fox Puss and took third at the Fredericksburg Amateur.
- Brittain won the first of his two Senior Amateur titles at Westwood in 2020, defeating Bowen Sargent in the championship match.
- Other past Senior Four-Ball winners in the field are Keith Decker, Steve Serrao, Cam Young, Bob Bailey, Robert Nussey, David Partridge, Pete DeTemple, and Jim Nirich.
- The field has crept closer to Brittain and Hurst in recent years. They won by five strokes in 2021, three strokes in 2022, and one stroke in 2023.
- Partridge is teaming with Dave Pulk in a pairing of players who have won VSGA Super Senior Golfer of the Year honors.
- One name worth watching: Robert Wrenn. The three-time State Open of Virginia champion and winner of the 1987 PGA Tour Buick Open regained his amateur status and qualified for this championship with Mike Ligon.
