

FIELD NOTES

For the second straight year, the Senior and Super Senior Multi-Format

as demand for the event exceeded capacity when it was played simultaneously with the open division in April. A Super Senior division for 65+ players was added for the first time in 2023. The brother duo of Steve and Jay (pictured) Serrao are back to defend their title. They put together an extremely impressive alternate shot round of 64 a year

ago to pull away from the field.



- All past champions are in the field, though not with the same partners. Jon Zampedro and Jeffrey Klatt won this event both in 2020 and 2021. Keith Decker and Jon Hurst won together in 2019. Hurst also won with David Jordan in 2022. Jordan will pair up with past VSGA Amateur champion Hank Klein this year.
- Buck Brittain has won every senior championship except for this one. Brittain has won the Senior Open twice, Senior Amateur twice, Senior Four-Ball three times and Senior Stroke Play once. Brittain will pair up with past Senior Amateur and Senior Four-Ball champion Cam Young at Lakeside. Brittain holds a 25-point lead over Steve Serrao for the top spot in the VSGA Senior Player Rankings, so this event could very well decide who wins the season-long points race.
- Brittain is one of two playing captains for the Virginias Captain's Putter team. Jordan Utley, who advanced to the round of 32 at last week's U.S. Mid-Amateur, is the other.
- Four Lakeside members are participating, including defending Super Senior champions Tim Kelley and Rusty Breeden. Lakeside's Bert Wilson will team with Jimmy Angel in the Super Senior division, and LPC member Chuck Sowers will pair with Eric Crain in the Senior division.
- Dave Pulk will partner with Skip Zobel for the second straight year in the Super Senior division. Just last week, Pulk beat Zobel in the first round of the VSGA Super Senior Amateur (65+) on his way to winning the title. Pulk beat David Partridge in the final match, and Partridge is teaming with Allan Strange for this event.
- Partridge was runner-up last year playing with Harry Thomas. This year, Thomas will pair up with past VSGA Super Senior Amateur champion Tim Vigotsky.
