FIELD NOTES

Last summer, Andrea Miller made history by becoming the only player to win four straight VSGA Senior Women's Amateurs. Now she'll try to join three others who have won five overall championships. Mimi Hoffman, Audrey Najjum, and Peggy Woodard all won five Senior Women's Am titles. Miller will be looking to do it in just her fifth appearance. Woodard is the only woman to go 5-0 in championship matches. Najjum is 5-2, Hoffman is 5-3. Miller has not played the 18th hole in any of her four championship-match appearances. She's defeated four different opponents: Bev Lane, Kay Tyler, Joanne Kitusky, and Boodie McGurn.



- Thirty-four golfers are attempting to qualify for the championship flight in the Senior Women's Amateur. Those not attempting to qualify will be placed in non-championship flights based upon Handicap Index.
- Hoffman is among those attempting to qualify for the championship as she seeks to become the first six-time champion of this event. She last won in 2019, defeating Shelley Savage in the championship match.
- Mary Gabriele, the 2017 winner, is competing in the Senior Women's Amateur championship flight. She is the only other past champion in that event's field.
- Eleven of the 16 players who advanced to match play in 2023 in the Senior Women's Amateur are in the field this year: Miller, Pam Reed, Gabriele, Cindy Thompson, Kay Stout, Lane, Nevia Cashwell, Sunny Small, Hoffman, and Kristin Shifflett.
- Shelley Savage and Maxine Bland made match play last year but have chosen to compete in the super senior championship this year.
- Twenty-two players will vie for the eight championship-flight match-play slots in the Super Senior Women's Amateur.
- Among those are the three past champions of the event: Shawn McCullough, Linda DiVall, and Dot Bolling.
- Bolling won the first three playings of the event: 2019, 2020, and 2021.
- The Super Senior Women's Amateur title match has reached the 18th hole just once, in 2020 when Bolling defeated Maggie Balch 1 up.
- Past Senior Women's Amateur champions competing in the Super Senior Women's Amateur this year include DiVall, Bolling, Savage, and McGurn.
