FIELD NOTES

David Prokop and Mark Boedicker (pictured) are looking to become the first side to win to win three straight Super Senior Four-Ball Championships. Their first two wins each came by a single stroke, which has been a theme since the field was split into age divisions starting in 2020. Three times, the title has been decided by one stroke, and the other time, it was decided in a sudden-death playoff. Jim Woodson will look for his third title with a third different partner. He won in 2019 with Leon Roday and 2020 with Jimmy Angel. He's playing with Jack Allara this week.



- There's one other past champion side participating in the 65+ division: John Steele and Bill Apple, who won in 2021 at Princess Anne CC.
- David Partridge and Harry Thomas have finished as 65+ runners-up in three of the last four years. That side has split, with Partridge playing with Allan Strange this year and Thomas pairing with Stephan E. Fay.
- Tim Kelley and Rusty Breeden, who won the VSGA Super Senior Multi-Format Team Championship last fall, will compete in the 65+ division.
- Richard Lion and Phil Goldberg, runners-up in 2022, are in the field.
- Charles Green III, who won the 70+ division with Bob Rotella last year, will compete in the 65+ division with Allen Barber. Rotella is not in the field.
- Player rankings points will only be awarded to those playing in the 65+ age division.
- There will be a guaranteed new champion in the 70-74 division, as none of the four previous winners are competing. Patrick Gregory won a title in the division with Jim Hudson in 2021 but will play with Mike Moore this year.
- Robert Gardiner, who won the 70-74 division at last year's VSGA Super Senior Amateur, is pairing with John Hoffman for this event.
- Rick Bendall and Steve Isaacs, one of three runners-up in the 70-74 division last year, are in the field.
- In the 75+ division, John Casstevens and George Owens will seek their third title in four years. Their bid to win their third straight title last year was thwarted by J.P. Leigh and Glenn Morris, who are back to defend their title.
- John Osborne and Bill Engel, one of three runners-up in the 70-74 division last year, will compete in the 75+ division this year.
