FIELD NOTES

The field is filled with brother tandems. Two years ago, Ben and Sam Beach (pictured) teamed to win the Four-Ball Championship at Piedmont Club, becoming the first brother tandem since Bill and Charles Baskerville in 1973 to win. Earlier this month, brothers Jay and Steve Serrao were victorious at the VSGA Senior Four-Ball Championship, earning them an exemption to this championship. Other brother duos in the field include Benson and Channing Blevins, Liam and Noah Maclauchlan, Matthew and Ryan Monastero, Daniel and David Goode, and Joe and Ryan McDonnell.



- Nick Taliaferro, who won his second Four-Ball title last year, is back with his original partner, Andrew Kennedy. The pair won in 2020. Taliaferro's partner last year, Patrick Gareiss, has turned professional.
- Two-time runners-up Joey Jordan and Drew Brockwell, former Virginia Tech teammates, will look to break through for their first win.
- Justin Young has played with Scott Shingler in the past in this event, but he'll partner with fellow Roanoke CC member Jason Spaar at Williamsburg.
- The Maclauchlan brothers earned their spot by winning the MAPGA/VSGA Junior Four-Ball Championship in March.
- Other past champion sides in the field: Adam Houck/Blake Carter (2022) and B.J. Maben/Kyle Mutter (2017). Past winners (playing with different partners than with whom they won) are Francesco Romano (2018), Harold Dill (2016), and Ryan Stinnett (2006-07).
- Dave Pulk (playing with Nathan Dean) is the only player who will have teed it up in the Senior Four-Ball, Super Senior Four-Ball, and Four-Ball Championships.
