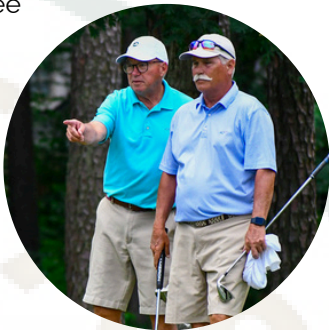

FIELD NOTES

For the first time since 2019, the Super Senior Four-Ball Championship visits the southwest corner of Virginia. All three age-division winners from 2024 are back to defend their titles, including Salisbury CC's Pat Gregory and Mike Moore in the 70+ division (pictured). Since the championship split into age divisions in 2020, only two sides have won the 75+ division: Two-time defending champions J.P. Leigh and Glenn Morris, and the side that won the previous three titles before that: George Owens and John Casstevens.



- Keith Decker soft launched his foray into super senior golf by playing from those tees as part of Chatmoss CC's entry into the VSGA Club Championship last month. He'll begin that journey in earnest at Blacksburg, as the VSGA's all-time wins leader will team with Jon Zampedro to compete in the 65+ division.
- Decker is one of three members of the Virginia Golf Hall of Fame competing. David Partridge (paired with Bill Willard) and J.P. Leigh (paired with Glenn Morris) are also in the field. Partridge has been on the runner-up side four times in the last five years.
- Four players in the field have won titles in this event but are paired with different partners this time around, including John Steele, Jim Woodson, Leon Roday, and Tom Grady. Steele, who won with Bill Apple, is teaming with fellow Westwood CC member Tim Krouse. Woodson, who has won with Jimmy Angel and Roday, will pair with Jack Allara. Roday is pairing with Jeff Flax. Grady, who won with Casstevens in 2014, is partnering with Skip Zobel.
- Woodson and Allara won last year's Super Senior Multi-Format Team Championship at Lakeside Park Club. They also teamed to win the Alleghany Amateur title last month at Blacksburg CC.
- Two members of host Blacksburg CC are in the field, but they're not playing together: Gary Leroux and Steve Roberson.
- Nearby Pete Dye River Course of Virginia Tech has the most players in the field with five.
- Close finishes have been the norm in the 65+ division since 2020. The last four championships have been decided by one stroke, and the 2020 championship was decided in a playoff. The 70+ division has been decided by one stroke in four of the past five years, including one that was decided in a playoff.
