FIELD NOTES

The combined VSGA Women's Stroke Play championships return for a second straight year. The VSGA Women's Mid-Amateur Championship, open to players ages 22 and older that are no longer active on a college golf roster, features defending champion Jessica Spicer (pictured) and this year's VSGA Women's Amateur champion, Lauren Greenlief, who made another deep run at the U.S. Women's Mid-Amateur Championship, advancing to the semifinals. New faces in this year's Mid-Amateur include former William & Mary golfer Mia Zanghetti and Emma Smithers, a past Louisiana Women's Amateur champion who now works for the Middle Atlantic PGA.



- Kristine Clites, who qualified for the U.S. Women's Mid-Amateur and works for the VSGA, is competing in the Women's Mid-Amateur.
- Mallory Kane, head women's golf coach at Old Dominion University, will compete in the Mid-Am division.
- The Senior Women's Stroke Play Championship boasts the largest field of the four events at Cavalier. Kristin Shifflett, who won the VSGA Senior Women's Amateur at The Homestead in August, will look to bolster her case for Senior Women's Golfer of the Year at Cavalier.
- The last time Andrea Miller played in this championship, in 2022 at Mount Vernon Country Club, she dusted the field by a whopping 14 strokes. Miller will go out in the final group with two other past champions in the field: defending champ Bev Lane and 2015-16 winner Mary Gabriele. Mimi Hoffman, who won in 2014, will go out in the penultimate group with Shifflett and 2022 runner-up Katie Cox.
- The Super Senior Women's Stroke Play Championship features an intriguing mix of players, including Casey Burley, who won the VSGA Super Senior Women's Amateur in August 1 up over Shawn McCullough, who is also in the field. McCullough is grouped with defending champion Shelley Savage and 2019 winner Boodie McGurn in the first round. Burley will play with 2022 winner Linda DiVall and Maxine Bland in the first round.
- Jane Marsh, last year's Net Women's Stroke Play champion, is not in the field this year, meaning the event will have a first-time winner. Chelsea Hester, who won in 2022, is not in the field either.
