

U.S. Senior Open Local Qualifying The Homestead (Cascades) May 6, 2025

NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This information supplements the Championship entry and the Standard Local Rules and Terms of Competition for 2025 USGA Championships)

TEE MARKERS/FORMAT: All play will be from the USGA tee markers. Qualifying and alternate spots will be determined over 18 holes of stroke play. Twelve (12) qualifying and two (2) alternate spots are available. A playoff for the final spot(s) and alternate spots will take place shortly after the last group finishes.

TRANSPORTATION: Local Rule as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect. Model Local Rule G-6: Players must walk at all times during the round. Caddies may ride in golf carts.

OUT OF BOUNDS: In addition to the line between the course-side points, at ground level, of white stakes and fence posts, Out of Bounds is also defined by the course side edge of Route 220. A ball at rest on or beyond Route 220 (Hole #1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 9) is deemed out of bounds even if the ball lies on another part of the course. For a ball in a tunnel under Route 220, the line between the course side points of the white dots within the tunnel define the out of bounds.

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS:

- Hole #12: The old cart path (now filled with grass, gravel, etc.) adjacent to the penalty area down the left side of the hole is deemed an immovable obstruction. If taking relief from the penalty area, players must drop a ball under Rule 17.1, then proceed under Rule 16.1, if applicable.
- Immovable Obstructions Close to Putting Green: Model Local Rule F-5.2 is in effect. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b if an immovable obstruction is on the line of play and is within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball. **Relief under this Local Rule is only allowed** when both the ball and immovable obstruction lie in an area cut to fairway height or less. There is no relief under this Local Rule if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable.
- Immovable Obstructions within or adjacent to each other, including but not limited to sprinkler heads near putting greens, are considered to be a single obstruction. Consult a referee with questions.
- Relief for Ball in Penalty Area: Relief under Model Local Rule F-24 may be available for interference of an immovable obstruction (sprinkler head, drain pipe, etc.) within one club-length of the edge of a penalty area, but only when the ball touches or lies on the obstruction or the obstruction interferes with the area of intended swing. Consult a referee with questions

RELIEF FROM AERATION HOLES: Model Local Rule E-4 is in effect. If a player's ball lies in or touches an aeration hole in the general area, the player may take relief under Rule 16.1b. If the ball comes to rest in another aeration hole the player may take relief again under this Local Rule. But interference does not exist if the aeration hole only interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing.

TEMPORARY MMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS: Model Local Rule F-23 is in effect. Temporary immovable obstructions include air-circulation fans near putting greens and all starting and scoring tents. Relief procedure may be taken on either side of the TIO.


