The Virginia State Golf Association will be launching an Adaptive Golf Program in 2025 and seeks a motivated candidate with a passion for golf and making a positive impact on the lives of others.

Position: Adaptive Golf Coordinator

Reports To: Director, Handicapping and Member Services

Job Functions: The responsibilities of this position include, but are not limited to, the following:

Clinics

- Schedule a series (6 to 8 weeks each) of adaptive golf clinics in the Northern Virginia,
 Richmond and Tidewater regions
- Work with VSGA staff to promote the clinics and organize registration
- Coordinate all aspects of each clinic and assist with instruction, as necessary
- Recruit local PGA Professionals to assist with instruction, as necessary

Play Days

- Schedule an adaptive play day in each of the three regions where clinics will be held
- Work with VSGA staff to promote the play days and organize registration
- Coordinate all aspects of each play day with the host club and serve as the on-site administrator

Resource Center

- Research the adaptive golf landscape in Virginia and beyond and help the VSGA to serve as a resource for golfers, golf clubs and other organizations by compiling relevant information for each stakeholder
- Work with VSGA staff to develop a webpage on VSGA.org dedicated to adaptive golf
- o Respond to inquiries from golfers and golf clubs concerning adaptive golf

Grants Program

- Assist in the creation and promotion of a grants program aimed at providing funding to golf clubs, organizations or individuals who are providing programming to adaptive golfers
- Work with VSGA staff to promote the grants program
- o Follow-up with grant recipients for feedback on their programming

Qualifications:

- College degree preferred
- Adaptive sports and/or golf instruction experience preferred, but all applicants will be strongly considered
- Effective communicator comfortable using a range of communication tools
- Ability to multi-task and work on projects with minimal supervision
- Must be able to handle physical activity and lift heavy items (50+ pounds)
- A valid U.S. driver's license and ability to travel within Virginia

- Base compensation for the responsibilities outlined above is \$10,000 per year
- Additional compensation based on participation numbers
- Cell phone allowance

- Paid expenses while on business travel
