NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This information supplements the Championship entry and the Standard Local Rules and Terms of Competition for 2025 VSGA Championships)

FORMAT/TEE MARKERS: 18-hole four-ball stroke play.

Four-Ball: BLACK tee markers | Senior Four-Ball: WHITE tee markers

OUT OF BOUNDS: In addition to the line between the course-side points, at ground level, of white stakes, PVC pipes, and wooden stakes with white tops, out of bounds is also defined by this course side edge of all public roads. A ball which comes to rest on or across a public road defined as out of bounds is out of bounds even though it may lie on another part of the course. The split rail fence behind #12 green and the driveway to the right of #17 also defines out of bounds. White lines define out of bounds. Wooden posts with numbers and white tops do not define out of bounds.

DROPPING ZONE: *Hole #18:* If during play of *hole #18*, a ball is in or it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found lies in the Red Penalty Area, the play may:

- i. Proceed under Rule 17.1d; or
- ii. As an additional option, drop a ball, under penalty of one stroke, in the dropping area located in the fairway.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR: Any areas defined with white lines is deemed ground under repair. Any area on the course that is roped off is also deemed ground under repair. Players may take relief under rule 16.1.

SCORING: The digital scorecard used via the Golf Genius app is the unofficial scorecard. The official scorecard is the paper scorecard which needs to be verified in the scoring area. Scoring will be located in the grill room.

CADDIES/TRANSPORTATION: Players may have a caddie and caddies may ride in carts only if there is a seat available. Spectators (outside influences) may ride in carts if there is a seat available.

Pace of Play: Please refer to the VSGA Standard Local Rules, and VSGA.org for the complete pace of play policy.

TIES/PLAYOFF: There are six (6) spots available for the VSGA Four-Ball Championship and seven (7) spots available for the VSGA Senior Four-Ball Championship. A sudden death playoff to determine the final spot and two (2) alternate spots for both the Four-Ball and Senior Four-Ball will be held immediately after the completion of play. If players are not present the winner of the playoff will be decided using a random method.
