





2026 VSGA Four-Ball & Senior Four-Ball Qualifying Pete Dye River Course of Virginia Tech | April 30, 2026

NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This information supplements the Championship entry and the Standard Local Rules and Terms of Competition for 2026 VSGA Championships)

FORMAT & TEE MARKERS: 18-hole four-ball stroke play.

- **SCORING:** The score to count **must be** clearly identified as the score of the individual partner who made that score. If this is not done, the side is disqualified.
- Four-Ball Qualifying – **Maroon** tee markers
- Senior Four-Ball Qualifying – **Orange** tee markers

OUT OF BOUNDS: In addition to the line between the course-side points, at ground level, of white stakes and fence posts, out of bounds is also defined by this course-side edge of all public roads. A ball which comes to rest on or across a public road defined as out of bounds is out of bounds even though it may lie on another part of the course.

DROPPING ZONES: *Holes #9 and #14* - If a ball is in the Red Penalty Area and last crossed between the two blue stakes, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found came to rest in the Red Penalty Area, the player has these relief options, each for one penalty stroke:

(i) proceed under Rule 17.1d; or

(ii) as an extra option, drop the original ball or another ball in the nearest Dropping Zone to where the ball crossed the edge of the Penalty Area on Hole #9; or in the Dropping Zone short of the bunker on Hole #14. The Dropping Zone is a relief area under Rule 14.3.

TIES/PLAYOFFS: There are **Four (4) spots** available in the Four-Ball qualifier and **two (2) spots** available in the Senior Four-Ball qualifier. A sudden death playoff to determine the final spot and two (2) alternate spots for both the Four-Ball and Senior Four-Ball will be held immediately after the completion of play. If sides are not present, the winner of the playoff will be decided by a random method.

CADDIES/TRANSPORTATION: Players may have a caddie and caddies may ride in carts only if there is a seat available. Spectators (outside influence) may ride in carts if there is a seat available.
