Notice to Players

(This information supplements the Championship entry and the Standard Local Rules and Terms of Competition for 2024 VSGA Championships)

Tee Markers

Boys

- 7 and under (VSGA Gold tees)
- 8-9 (VSGA Gold tees)
- 10-11 (VSGA Green tees)
- 12-13 (VSGA White tees)
- 14-15 (VSGA Red tees)
- 16-18 (VSGA Red tees)

Girls

- 9 and under (VSGA Gold tees)
- 10-11 (VSGA Green tees)
- 12-13 (VSGA Green tees)
- 14-15 (VSGA White tees)
- 16-18 (VSGA White tees)

Format

All players will play nine-holes.

Players should use the "triple bogey" rule during the championship. If a player's score reaches a score of triple bogey of the hole being played, they are encouraged to pick up.

Transportation

Players and caddies must walk at all times. Players may get a ride to the first tee and after their round, but not during the round.

Caddies

Players are allowed to have caddies with no age restrictions.

Out of Bounds

Out of bounds is defined by the inside edge of white stakes and public roads. A ball which comes to rest on or across a public road is out of bounds even though it may lie on another part of the course.

Scoring

The digital scorecard used via the Golf Genius app is the unofficial scorecard. The official scorecard is the paper scorecard which needs to be verified in the scoring area (located near the pro shop).

Prizes/Playoff

Any ties for age group winner will be settled using the USGA Scorecard Playoff method (*last 9, last 6, last 3, last hole, flip of a coin*). In the case of a nine-hole tournament, the last 6 holes will be used first, then last 3, last hole, flip of a coin.
