

# 79th Captain's Putter Matches Bayville Golf Club October 18-19, 2024

#### NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This information supplements the Standard Local Rules and Terms of Competition for 2024 VSGA Championships – see reverse side.)

#### Tee Markers:

Open players - black tee markers Senior players - green tee markers Super Senior players - blue tee markers

### Format:

Round 1 – Four-Ball Round 2 – Foursomes Round 3 – Singles One point is available per match. If the match is tied at the end of 18 holes, each side will receive a 1/2 point.

<u>Advice</u>: One designated team captain may give advice to members of their team.

<u>**Out of Bounds</u>**: Out of bounds is defined by the inside edge of white stakes/fence posts at ground level. Roads do not define out of bounds.</u>

## Immovable Obstructions:

- Immovable obstructions adjacent to each other, including but not limited to sprinkler heads near putting greens, etc., are considered to be a single obstruction.
- Immovable Obstructions Close to Putting Green: Model Local Rule F-5.2 is in effect. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b if an immovable obstruction is on the line of play and is within two club-lengths of the Putting Green and within two club-lengths of the ball. Relief under this Local Rule is only allowed when both the ball and the Immovable Obstruction lie in an area cut to fairway height or less. There is no relief under this Local Rule if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable.
- Temporary Immovable Obstructions: Model Local Rule F-23 is in effect. Temporary immovable obstructions include air-circulation fans near putting greens and all starting and scoring tents. Relief may be taken on either side of the TIO.

**Faint Painted Lines:** Players must disregard any very faint red penalty area markings. However, all white ground under repair markings (some more prevalent than others) have status and players make take free relief from these areas.
