## VSGA Senior & Super Senior Multi-Format Team Championship Lakeside Park Club

### Notice to Players

(This information supplements the Championship entry and the Standard Local Rules and Terms of Competition for 2024 VSGA Championships.)



**TEE MARKERS:** Senior Division: Green VSGA tee markers

Super Senior Division: White VSGA tee markers.

**FORMAT:** Modified Foursomes (modified alternate shot): Both players play from the teeing area, one of the tee shots is selected and players alternate shots from there until the ball is holed. Example: Player A's tee shot is selected, player B plays next, then A and so on until the ball is holed.

**PREFERRED LIES:** When a player's ball lies in a part of the general area cut to fairway height or less on the hole being played, the player may take free relief once by placing the original ball or another ball and playing it from this relief area:

- Reference Point: Spot of the original ball.
- Size of the Relief Area Measured from Reference Point: One VSGA scorecard length, must not be nearer the hole than the reference point and must be in the general area.

**OUT OF BOUNDS:** In addition to the line between the course-side points, at ground level, of white stakes and fence posts, out of bounds is also defined by the course-side edge of all public roads and club parking lot. A ball which comes to rest on or across a public road defined as out of bounds is out of bounds even though it may lie on another part of the course.

**TEMPORARY IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS:** Model Local Rule F-23 is in effect for greenside fans. Relief procedure may be taken on either side of the TIO.

**SCORING:** The digital scorecard used via the Golf Genius app is the unofficial scorecard. The official scorecard is the paper scorecard which needs to be verified in the scoring area. The scoring area will be located on the patio outside the pro shop.

**CADDIES/TRANSPORTATION:** Players may have a caddie and caddies may ride in carts only if there is a seat available. Spectators (outside influences) may ride in carts if there is a seat available.

**PACE OF PLAY:** Please refer to the VSGA Standard Local Rules, and VSGA.org for the complete pace of play policy.

**PRIZES:** Prizes will be awarded to the overall champions in each division and top finishers in each flight. A tie for the overall champions in each division will be decided by a sudden death playoff using the modified foursomes format. Ties for all other prizes will be broken using the USGA scorecard playoff method (Holes 10-18, Holes 13-18, Holes 16-18, Hole 18, random method).
