**NOTICE TO PLAYERS**

This information supplements the Championship entry. The Local Rules and Terms of Competition for 2024 USGA Championships can be found on the reverse side.

**Tee Markers:** Girls: USGA white tee markers | Boys: USGA blue tee markers

**Format:** 18-hole stroke play.

**One Ball Rule:** Local Rule as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is **not** in effect.

**Caddies:** Caddies are not required. If you have a caddie they must walk or use a push/pull cart. Caddies must not be a parent, step parent, or guardian.

**Distance-Measuring Devices:** A player may obtain distance information by use of a distance-measuring device. If a player uses a distance-measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions (e.g. elevation changes, wind speed, etc.) the player is in breach of Rule 4.3.

**Grooves and Punch Mark Specifications:** The players clubs **must conform** to the grooves and punch mark specification in The Rules of Golf that are effective from January 1, 2010 (see Model Local Rule G-3).

**Footwear:** Rule 4.3 is modified in this way: During a round, a player must not wear shoes with traditionally-designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic, plastic, etc.) or spikes, of any design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (if such metal may come in contact with the course). Penalty for breach of this Local Rule: See Rule 4.3.

**Transportation:** Local Rule as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect. Model Local Rule G-6. Players must walk at all times during a round. Caddies may ride in golf carts.

**Out of Bounds:** In addition to the line between the course-side points, at ground level, of white stakes and fence posts, out of bounds is also defined by this course side edge of all asphalt surfaces (entrance road, parking lot, cart staging area) by Holes #1, #15, and #18. A ball which comes to rest on or across a public road defined as out of bounds is out of bounds even though it may lie on another part of the course.

**Faded Paint Lines:** Faded paint lines have no meaning for this competition.

**Scorecards/Scoring Area**

The digital scorecard used via the app is the unofficial scorecard. The official scorecard is the paper scorecard which needs to be verified in the scoring area.

**Qualifying Spots/Playoff Information:**

Girls: Three (3) qualifiers and two (2) alternates will be determined. A starting time for play-off(s) for qualifying or alternate spots will be announced at the scoreboard when the last group finishes play.

Boys: Four (4) qualifiers and two (2) alternates will be determined. A starting time for play-off(s) for qualifying or alternate spots will be announced at the scoreboard when the last group finishes play.
