NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This information supplements the Championship entry and the Standard Local Rules and Terms of Competition for 2024 VSGA Championships)



FORMAT/TEE MARKERS: 18-hole four-ball stroke play.

Four-Ball: **BLUE** tee markers | Senior Four-Ball: **WHITE** tee markers

SCORING: The score to count **must be** clearly identified as the score of the individual partner who made that score. If this is not done, the side is disqualified.

PREFERRED LIES: When a player's ball lies in a part of the general area cut to fairway height or less on the hole being played, the player may take free relief once by placing the original ball or another ball in the general area within **one scorecard length**, no closer to the hole from where the original ball lay.

OUT OF BOUNDS: The line between the course-side points, at ground level, of fence posts define out of bounds.

OBSTRUCTIONS:

- Immovable obstructions adjacent to each other, including but not limited to sprinkler heads near putting greens, etc., are considered to be a single obstruction.
- Immovable Obstructions Close to Putting Green: Model Local Rule F-5.2 is in effect. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b if an immovable obstruction is on the line of play and is within two club-lengths of the Putting Green and within two club-lengths of the ball. **Relief under this Local Rule is only allowed when both the ball and the Immovable Obstruction lie in an area cut to fairway height or less.** There is no relief under this Local Rule if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable.

CADDIES/TRANSPORTATION: Players may have a caddie and caddies may ride in carts only if there is a seat available. Spectators (outside influences) may ride in carts if there is a seat available.

PACE OF PLAY: Please refer to the VSGA Standard Local Rules, and VSGA.org for the complete pace of play policy.

TIES/PLAYOFF: There are **six (6) spots** available for the VSGA Four-Ball Championship and **ten (10) spots** available for the Senior Four-Ball Championship. A sudden death playoff to determine the final spot and two (2) alternate spots for both the Four-Ball and Senior Four-Ball will be held immediately after the completion of play. If sides are not present the winner of the playoff will be decided by a random method.
