

82nd VSGA Club Championship The Foundry Golf Club April 28, 2025

NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This information supplements the Championship entry and the Standard Local Rules and Terms of Competition for 2025 VSGA Championships)

TEE MARKERS:

49 & Under: GOLD VSGA tee markers50-64: GREEN VSGA tee markers

65 & Over and all Women: WHITE VSGA tee markers

FORMAT/SCORING: Each club divides its four players into two four-ball sides. The club's total score is determined by adding the two four-ball scores together.

• The score to count for each four-ball side must be clearly identified as the score of the individual partner who made that score on the paper scorecard.

PREFERRED LIES: When a player's ball lies in a part of the general area cut to fairway height or less on the hole being played, the player may take free relief once by placing the original ball or another ball and playing it from this relief area:

- Reference Point: Spot of the original ball.
- Size of Relief Area Measured from Reference Point: One club-length, must not be nearer the hole than the reference point and must be in the general area.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR: The following areas are not marked but are deemed ground under repair. Consult a referee or play second ball if there are any questions:

- All newly sodded areas
- Circular areas of dirt or newly planted grass where a tree has been removed

OUT OF BOUNDS: Out of bounds is defined by the inside edge of all roads, excluding the road behind the 6th green and the road in front of the 14th tee (during play of Hole #14 only). A ball which comes to rest on or across a road defining out of bounds is out of bounds even though it may lie on another part of the course.

DROPPING ZONES – HOLE #3, #7 & #11: If a ball is in or it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found lies in the Penalty Area, the player may proceed under Rule 17.1d or, as an additional option, drop a ball, under penalty of one stroke, in the dropping zone.

Hole #3: Forward tee
Hole #7: Near pond
Hole #11: Forward tee

PACE OF PLAY: Please refer to the VSGA Standard Local Rules, and VSGA.org for the complete pace of play policy.

PRIZES & TIES: Gift certificates for Amateurs will be available in the Foundry Pro Shop after the event is over. Professionals will have their prize money direct deposited through the MAPGA (if applicable) or a check will be sent in the mail. The top 10 teams will receive prizes and any ties will split prizes equally. If there is a tie for the overall champion, those teams will all be awarded a trophy and have their name engraved on the perpetual trophy.
