

2025 VSGA Amateur Last Chance Qualifying Lake Chesdin Golf Club June 17, 2025

Notice to Players

(This information supplements the Championship entry and the Standard Local Rules and Terms of Competition for 2025 VSGA Championships)

Tee Markers: All play will be from the Gold tees.

Format: 18-hole individual stroke play. The low 5 scorers will advance to the VSGA Amateur Championship.

Out of Bounds: In addition to the line between the course-side points, at ground level, of white stakes and fence posts, out of bounds is also defined by the course side edge of all asphalt surfaces. A ball which comes to rest on or across a public road defined as out of bounds is out of bounds even though it may lie on another part of the course.

Faint/Old Paint Lines: Disregard any faded/faint red, yellow and white paint lines.

Dropping Zones: If a ball is in or it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found is in the penalty area, the player may:

- proceed under Rule 17; or
- as an additional option, drop the original ball or another ball, under penalty of one stroke, anywhere in the dropping zone provided.
 - Hole #4: In front of forward tee.
 - **Hole #8:** At the end of the fairway (right side).
 - Hole #11: In front of the most forward tee.
 - Hole #18: At the end of the fairway.

Temporary Immovable Obstructions: Model Local Rule F-23 is in effect for greenside fans. Relief procedure may be taken on either side of the TIO.

Caddies/Transportation: Players may have a caddie and caddies may ride in carts only if there is a seat available. Spectators (outside influences) may ride in carts if there is a seat available.

Scoring: The digital scorecard used via the Golf Genius app is the unofficial scorecard. The official scorecard is the paper scorecard which needs to be verified in the scoring area. The scoring area is located in the pavilion behind hole #18.

Ties/Playoff: A sudden death playoff to determine the final spot will be held immediately after the completion of play. There will be no alternates from this qualifier.

Pace of Play: Please refer to the VSGA Standard Local Rules, and VSGA.org for the complete pace of play policy.
