

2025 VSGA Amateur/State Open of Virginia Qualifying Elizabeth Manor Golf and Country Club June 10, 2025

Notice to Players

(This information supplements the Championship entry and the Standard Local Rules and Terms of Competition for 2025 VSGA Championships)

Format/Tee Markers: 18-hole stroke play. All play will be from the Black tees.

Out of Bounds: In addition to the line between the course-side points, at ground level, of white stakes and fence posts, out of bounds is also defined by the course side edge of all asphalt surfaces. A ball which comes to rest on or across a public road defined as out of bounds is out of bounds even though it may lie on another part of the course.

Faint/Old Paint Lines: Disregard any faded/faint red, yellow and white paint lines.

Dropping Zone - **Hole #9**: If a ball is in or it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found is in the penalty area, the player may:

- proceed under Rule 17.1d; or
- as an additional option, drop the original ball or another ball, under penalty of one stroke, anywhere in the dropping zone provided.
 - The entire forward tee will act as the dropping zone.

Power Lines: If it is known or virtually certain that a player's ball hit a power line (or tower or a wire or pole supporting a power line) during the play of the hole, the stroke does not count. The player must play a ball without penalty from where the previous stroke was made.

Caddies/Transportation: Players may have a caddie and caddies may ride in carts only if there is a seat available. Spectators (outside influences) may ride in carts if there is a seat available.

Scoring: The digital scorecard used via the Golf Genius app is the unofficial scorecard. The official scorecard is the paper scorecard which needs to be verified in the scoring area.

Ties/Playoff: There are seven (7) spots available for the VSGA Amateur Championship and three (3) spots available for the State Open of Virginia. A sudden death playoff to determine the final spot and three (3) alternate spots for both the VSGA Amateur Championship and State Open of Virginia will be held immediately after the completion of play. If players are not present the winner of the playoff will be decided using a random method.

Pace of Play: Please refer to the VSGA Standard Local Rules, and VSGA.org for the complete pace of play policy.
