



35th VSGA Junior Match Play Championship

Stonehenge Golf & Country Club

July 27-30, 2026

Notice to Players

(This information supplements the Championship entry and the Standard Local Rules and Terms of Competition for 2026 VSGA Championships)

Tees/Format: All play will be from the VSGA tee markers.

- **Stroke Play:**

July 27: 18-hole individual stroke play. (field cut to low 60 players and ties)

July 28: Round two of 18-hole individual stroke play qualifying

(top 16 players advance to match play; if needed, players will playoff for the last spot(s) to make match play)

- **Match Play:**

Singles match play. If a match is all square after 18 holes, the match will return to hole #1. The round is extended until a hole is won.

July 29: Round of 16 and Quarterfinals of match play

July 30: Semifinal and Final matches

Caddies: Players may have a caddie, but he/she must meet the same age requirements for the tournament as the player. Players may only ride when in a committee provided shuttle.

Out of Bounds: In addition to the line between the course-side points, at ground level, of white stakes and fence posts, out of bounds is also defined by the course side edge of all public roads, including the entrance road. A ball which comes to rest on or across a public road defined as out of bounds is out of bounds even though it may lie on another part of the course.

Integral Object – Hole #4: The wooden support wall for the bunker in front of the putting green is an integral object, and no free relief will be given.

Flowerbed – Hole #8: The flowerbed encircled by the cart path to the right of the green on Hole #8 is considered part of the cart path. Free relief is allowed under Rule 16.1.

Dropping Zone – Hole #10: For a ball that crosses the penalty area between the blue stakes behind the green, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball has not been found came to rest in the penalty area, the player has these relief options, each for one penalty stroke:

- Proceed under Rule 17.1d; or
- As an additional option, drop the original ball or another ball in the nearest dropping zone (DZ) located at the back left and right of the green. All dropping zones for this competition are marked by a VSGA dropping zone sign. These dropping zones are for a ball last crossing the edge of the penalty area **between the blue stakes only.**

Pace of Play: Please refer to the VSGA Standard Local Rules, and VSGA.org for the complete pace of play policy.

Scorecard/Scoring: The digital scorecard used via the app is the unofficial scorecard. The official scorecard is the paper scorecard, which needs to be verified in the scoring area. The scoring area is located in the pavilion.
