NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(Play will be in accordance with USGA Rules, the VSGA Local Rules and Terms of the Competition and the following local rules. Penalty for breach of a local rule is a general penalty, unless otherwise noted.)

TEE MARKERS: All play will be from the **WHITE** tee markers.

FORMAT: 18-hole stroke play. Each team total is determined by using the low 4 of 6 scores on each team. **The maximum score to count for each player on each hole is double par.**

TIES: Only ties for first and second place in the team competition will be broken using the following:

- 1) the fifth lowest score of the teams;
- 2) the sixth lowest score of the teams;
- 3) the lowest individual score of the teams;
- 4) the lowest individual scores on individual holes, starting with the #1 handicap hole, until the tie is broken.

OUT OF BOUNDS: In addition to the line between the course-side points, at ground level, of white stakes and fence posts, out of bounds is also defined by this course-side edge of all public roads. A ball which comes to rest on or across a public road defined as out of bounds is out of bounds even though it may lie on another part of the course.

PREFERRED LIES: When a player's ball lies in a part of the general area cut to fairway height or less on the hole being played, the player may take free relief once by placing the original ball or another ball and playing it from this relief area:

- Reference Point: Spot of the original ball.
- Size of Relief Area Measured from Reference Point: One club-length, must not be nearer the hole than the reference point and must be in the general area.

ADVICE: Model Local Rule H-2 is in effect for this competition. Each team may appoint two people who may give advice to members of that team. Advice may not be given when a player's ball lies on the putting green.

- First offense – warning
- Second offense – one stroke penalty
- Third and subsequent offenses – general penalty

TRANSPORTATION: Players must walk during the round, unless riding in a Committee-approved shuttle.

PACE OF PLAY: Please refer to the VSGA Standard Local Rules and VSGA.org for the complete pace of play policy. The allotted time is 4 hours and 35 minutes.
