**NOTICE TO PLAYERS**

(This information supplements the Championship entry and the Standard Local Rules and Terms of Competition for 2026 VSGA Championships)

**TEE MARKERS/FORMAT:** All play will be from the RED VSGA tee markers. 36-hole stroke play qualifying. The low 32 qualifiers advance to match play.

**TIES/PLAYOFF:** A sudden death playoff will be held if there is a tie for the final match play spot (playoff holes to be announced). Ties for match play seeding will be settled by a blind draw except that places of those participating in the playoff to determined the final spot(s) in the match play field will be determined by performance in the playoff.

**OUT OF BOUNDS:** Out of bounds is defined by the inside edge of white stakes and fence posts at ground level. Roads do not define out of bounds.

**IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS:**

- Immovable Obstructions Close to Putting Green: MLR F-5.2 is in effect. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b if an Immovable Obstruction is on the line of play and is within two club-lengths of the Putting Green and within two club-lengths of the ball. **Relief under this Local Rule is only allowed when both the ball and the Immovable Obstruction lie in an area cut to fairway height or less.**
- Immovable Obstructions within or adjacent to each other, including but not limited to sprinkler heads near putting greens, are considered to be a single obstruction. Consult a referee with questions.
- Temporary Immovable Obstructions: Model Local Rule F-23 is in effect. Temporary immovable obstructions include air-circulation fans near putting greens and all starting and scoring tents. Relief may be taken on either side of the TIO.

**SCORING:** The digital scorecard used via the Golf Genius app is the unofficial scorecard. The official scorecard is the paper scorecard which needs to be verified in the scoring area (located at the VSGA tent).

**PACE OF PLAY:** Please refer to the championship website for the complete pace of play policy.

**CADDIES/TRANSPORTATION:** Players may have a caddie and caddies may ride in carts only if there is a seat available. Spectators (outside influences) may ride in carts if there is a seat available. No one may ride on the back of a cart.
