NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This information supplements the Championship entry and the Standard Local Rules and Terms of Competition for 2025 VSGA Championships)

TEE MARKERS:

- Mid-Senior – GOLD VSGA tee markers
- 65 & Over – GREEN VSGA tee markers
- 70 & Over – WHITE VSGA tee markers
- 75 & Over – RED VSGA tee markers

FORMAT: 18-hole stroke play qualifying. Either the Top 16 or Top 8 players (depending on division) will advance to match play.

- Mid-Senior – Top 8 Players
- 65 & Over – Top 16 Players
- 70 & Over – Top 16 Players
- 75 & Over – Top 8 Players

TIES/PLAYOFF: A sudden death playoff will be held if there is a tie for the final match play spot in any championship. Ties for match play seeding will be settled by a blind draw except that places of those participating in the playoff to determine the final spot(s) in the match play field will be determined by performance in the playoff.

OUT OF BOUNDS: In addition to the line between the course-side points, at ground level, of white stakes and fence posts, out of bounds is also defined by:

- Inside edge of the entrance road. A ball that comes to rest across the entrance road is out of bounds, even though it may be on another part of the course.
- The white line on Hole #15. Any stakes are used to identify this area and are movable obstructions.
- The pavement of the parking lot behind Hole #18. Two white dots define the start of the parking lot and the end of the cart path.

WRONG GREEN: All practice putting and chipping greens (e.g. right of Hole #18) are wrong greens and players must take free relief under Rule 13.1f.

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS:

- Immovable Obstructions Close to Putting Green: MLR F-5.2 is in effect. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b if an Immovable Obstruction is on the line of play and is within two club-lengths of the Putting Green and within two club-lengths of the ball. **Relief under this Local Rule is only allowed when both the ball and the Immovable Obstruction lie in an area cut to fairway height or less.**
- Immovable Obstructions within or adjacent to each other, including but not limited to sprinkler heads near putting greens, are considered to be a single obstruction. Consult a referee with questions.

SCORING: The digital scorecard used via the Golf Genius app is the unofficial scorecard. The official scorecard is the paper scorecard which needs to be verified in the scoring area.
