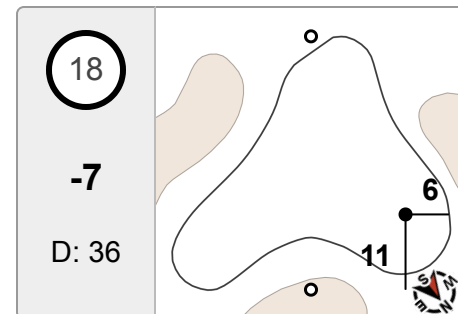
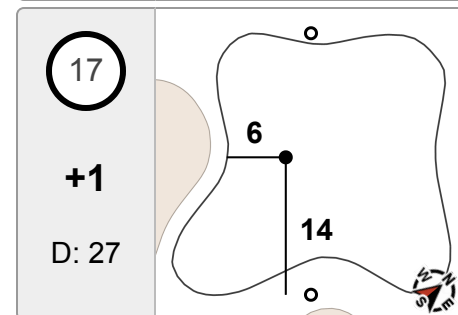
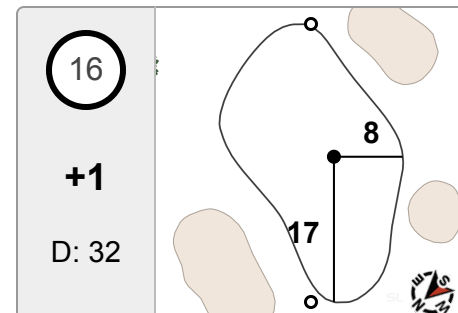
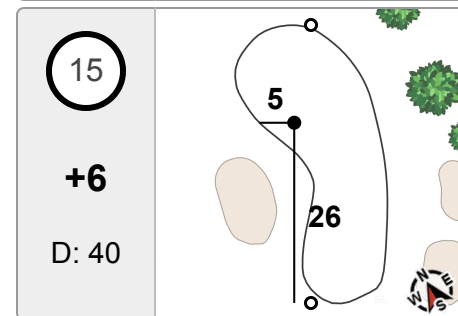
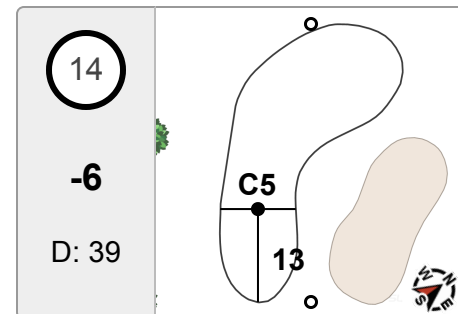
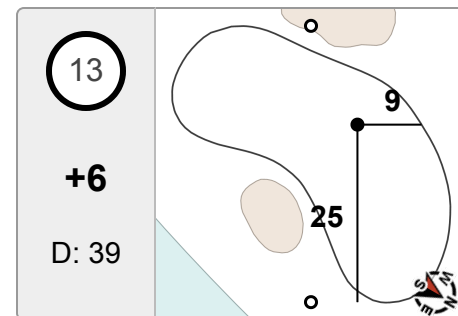
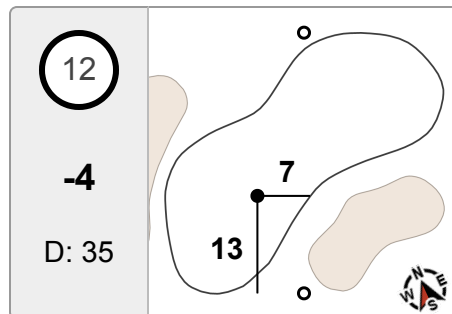
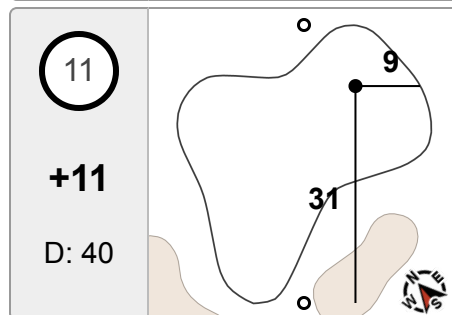
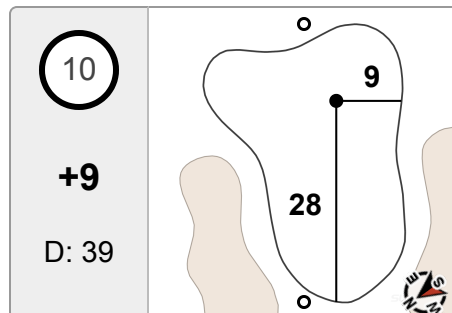
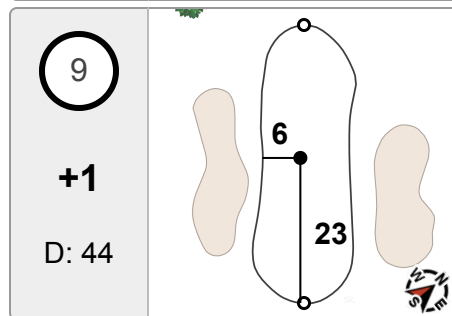
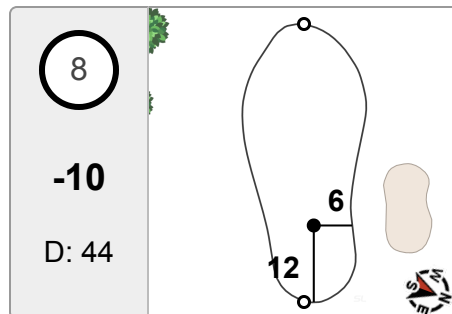
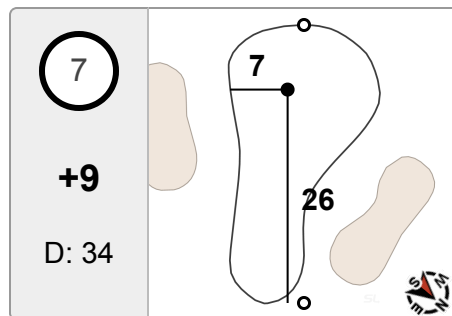
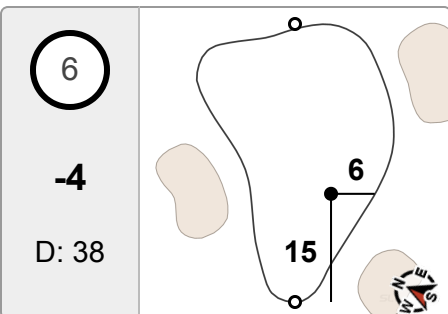
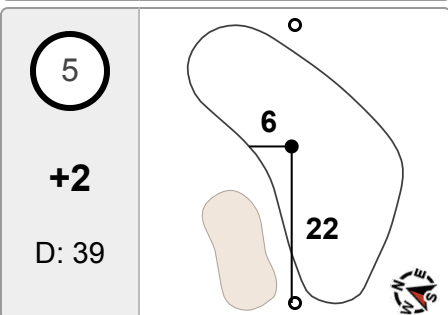
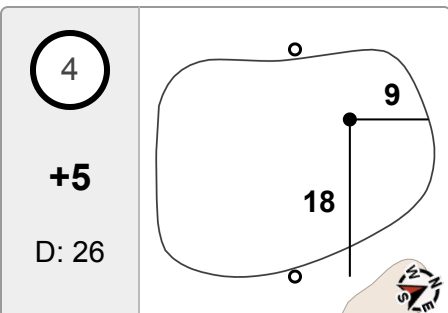
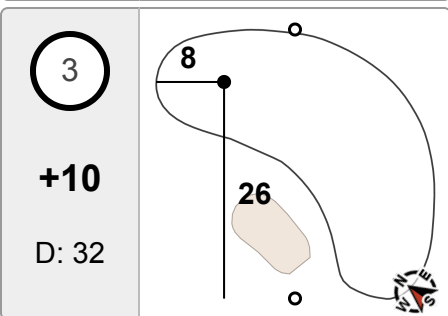
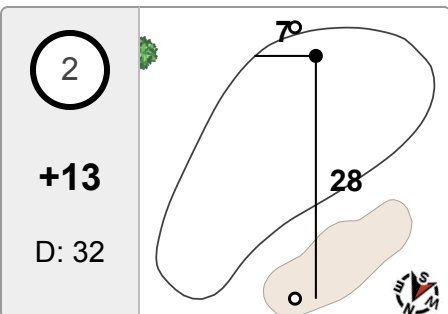
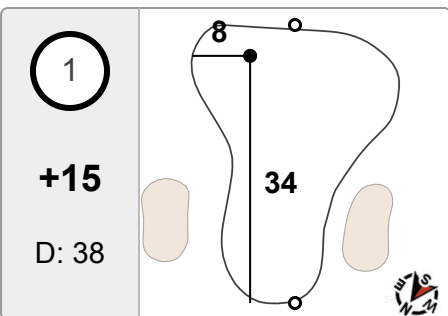






VSGA Senior Amateur/Senior Open of Virginia Qualifying

Notice to Players

(This information supplements the Championship entry and the Standard Local Rules and Terms of Competition for 2026 VSGA Championships)

FORMAT & TEE MARKERS: 18-hole stroke play. Play will be from the **Blue** tee markers.

TIES/PLAYOFF: There are three (3) spots available for the VSGA Senior Amateur Championship and one (1) spot available for the Senior Open of Virginia. A sudden death playoff to determine the final spot and three (3) alternate spots for both the VSGA Senior Amateur Championship and Senior Open of Virginia will be held immediately after the completion of play. If players are not present the winner of the playoff will be decided using a random method.

OUT OF BOUNDS: Out of bounds is defined by the line between the course side points, at ground level, of white stakes, pipes, and fence posts. The course parking lot right of #9 green and behind #18 green is out of bounds.

WRONG PUTTING GREENS: The practice putting green is a wrong green and free relief **MUST** be taken.

DROPPING ZONE: Hole #8 and #13 – if a ball is in or it is known to be virtually certain that a ball that has not been found is in the penalty area, the player may proceed under Rule 17.1d; or

As an additional option, drop a ball, under penalty of one stroke on the forward most teeing area (Hole #8), or drop a ball, under penalty of one stroke in the designated dropping zone area marked with a white circle (Hole #13).

SCORECARDS & SCORING AREA: The digital scorecard used via the Golf Genius app is the unofficial scorecard. The official scorecard is the paper scorecard which needs to be verified in the scoring area which will be on the patio facing the practice putting green.

CADDIES/TRANSPORTATION: Players may have a caddie and caddies may ride in carts only if there is a seat available. Spectators (outside influences) may ride in carts if there is a seat available.

PACE OF PLAY: Please refer to the VSGA Standard Local Rules, and VSGA.org for the complete pace of play policy.
