**NOTICE TO PLAYERS**

Play will be in accordance with USGA Rules, the VSGA Intercollegiate Conditions of the Competition, the NCAA Local Rules and Conditions of Competition (reverse side) and the following local rules. Penalty for breach of a local rule is two strokes, unless otherwise noted.



**TEE MARKERS/FORMAT:** All play will be from the Green VSGA tee markers. 36-hole individual stroke play competition.

**ONE-BALL RULE:** The one-ball rule is not in effect for this competition. Please disregard this condition of the competition on the reverse side of this notice to players.

**OUT OF BOUNDS:** Is defined by the line between the course-side points, at ground level, of white stakes, public roads, and fence posts. A ball which comes to rest on or across a public road defined as out of bounds is out of bounds even though it may lie on another part of the course.

**DROPPING ZONE - Hole #6:** If, during play of Hole #6, a ball is in or it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found lies in the Yellow Penalty Area, the player may:

- i. proceed under Rule 17.1d; or
- ii. as an additional option, drop a ball, under penalty of one stroke, in the dropping zone (most forward tee).

**ADVICE:** Model Local Rule H-2 is in effect for this competition. Each team may appoint two people (in addition to the persons from whom advice may be asked under that Rule) who may give advice to members of that team. These people must be identified to the Committee before giving advice.

**SCORING:** The digital scoreboard used via the Golf Genius app is the unofficial scorecard. The official scorecard is the paper scorecard which needs to be verified in the scoring area (located near the 18th green).

**PLAYOFF INFORMATION:** A sudden-death playoff will be used to determine the individual medalist only. Ties for all other individual prizes will be decided by using the USGA scorecard method (last 9, last 6, last 3, last hole and flip of coin) from the final round.

**PACE OF PLAY:** Please refer to the official scorecard, VSGA Standard Local Rules, and VSGA.org for the complete pace of play policy.
