**Notice to Players**

*(This information supplements the Championship entry and the Standard Local Rules and Terms of Competition for 2024 VSGA Championships)*



**FORMAT/TEE MARKERS:** 18-hole stroke play. All play will be from the **Maroon** tees.

**CADDIES/TRANSPORTATION:** Players may have a caddie and caddies may ride in carts only if there is a seat available. Spectators (outside influences) may ride in carts if there is a seat available.

**OUT OF BOUNDS:** Defined by inside points, at ground level, of wooden white stakes and white PVC stakes (see below for additional items on specific holes). A ball which comes to rest beyond an object which defines out of bounds is out of bounds even though it may lie on another part of the course.

**Hole #3** – The inside points, at ground level, of the guard rail posts adjacent to the road define out of bounds.

**Hole #9** – The inside edge of the entrance road and parking lot define out of bounds.

**Hole #10** – The pool and tennis areas right of the fairway are out of bounds. The margin is determined by the inside points, at ground level, of the fence posts/wall.

**PACE OF PLAY:** Please refer to the VSGA Standard Local Rules, and VSGA.org for the complete pace of play policy.

**TIES/PLAYOFF:** There are **four (4) spots** available for the VSGA Amateur Championship and **one (1) spots available** for the State Open of Virginia. A sudden death playoff to determine the final spot and three (3) alternate spots for both the VSGA Amateur Championship and State Open of Virginia will be held immediately after the completion of play. If players are not present the winner of the playoff will be decided using a random method.
