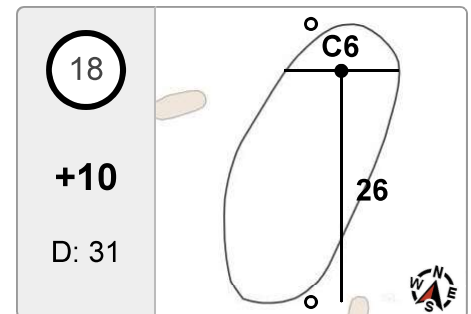
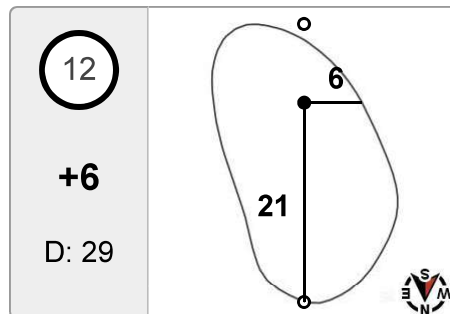
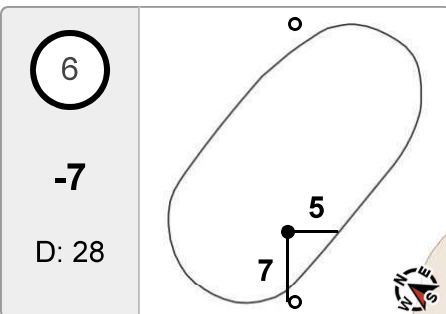
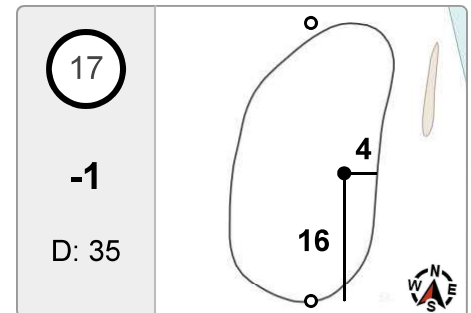
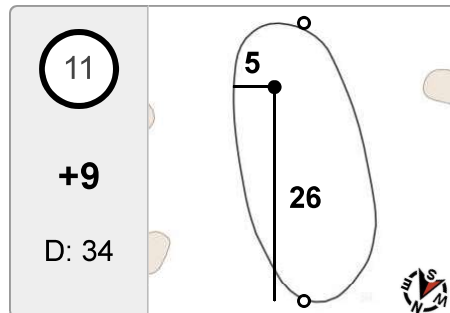
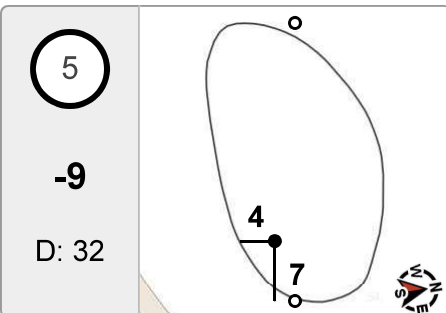
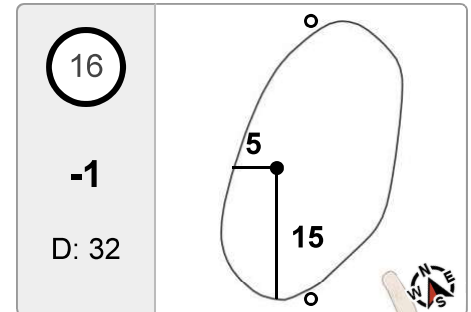
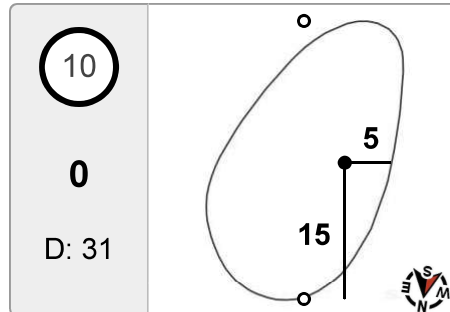
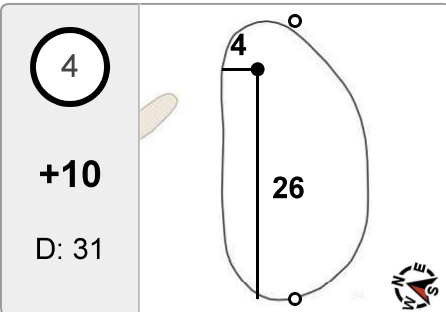
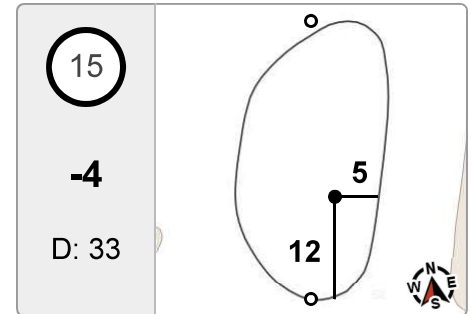
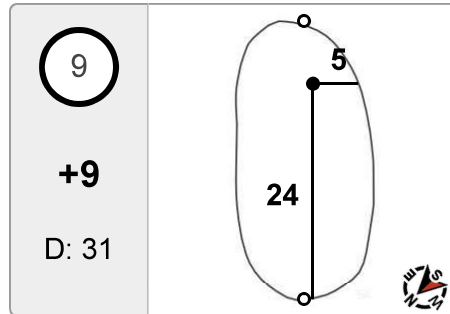
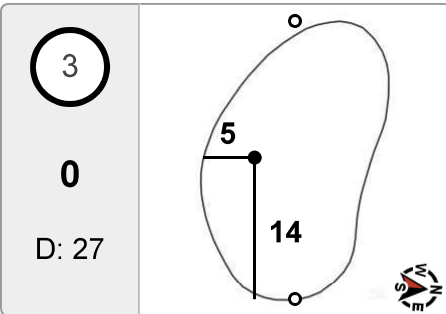
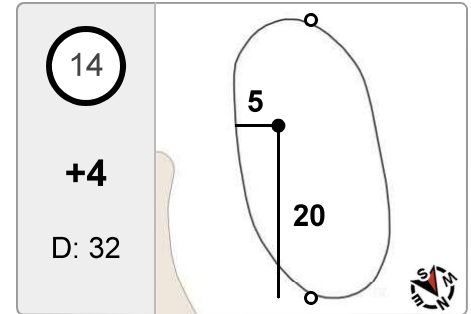
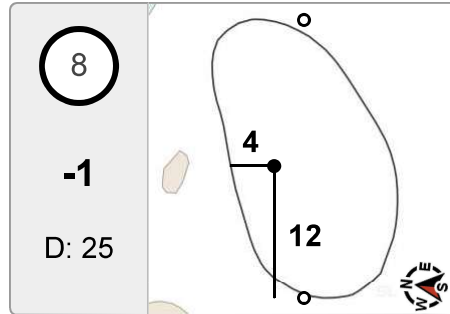
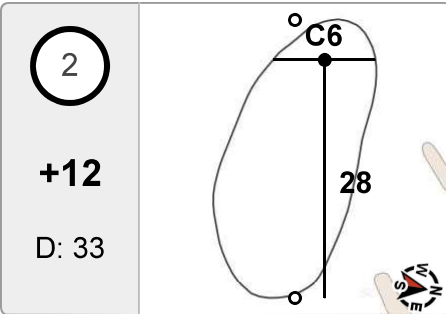
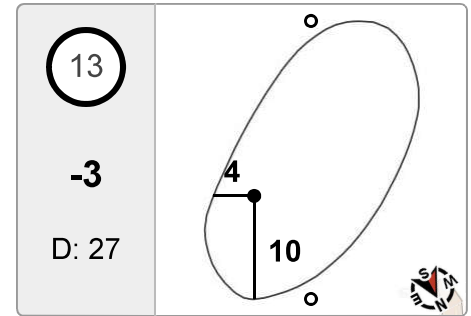
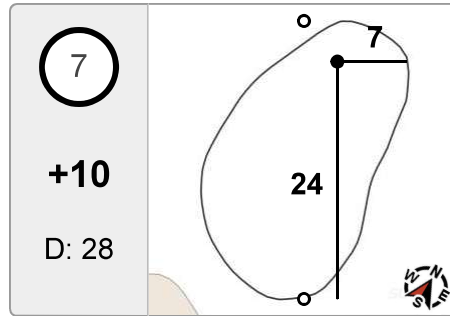
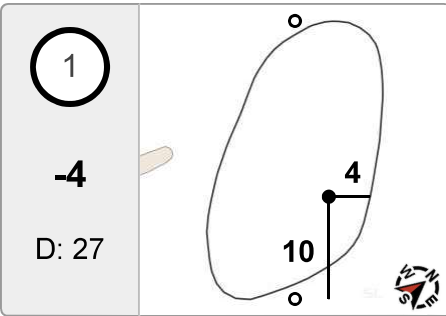






74th VSGA Junior Stroke Play Championship

Pete Dye River Course of Virginia Tech

July 7-9, 2026

NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This information supplements the Championship entry and the Standard Local Rules and Terms of Competition for 2026 VSGA Championships)

Tee Markers: All play will be from the VSGA red tee markers.

Format: 54-hole, stroke play competition. The field will be cut to the low 45 players and ties following round two.

Out of Bounds: In addition to the line between the course-side points, at ground level of white stakes, out of bounds is also defined by the course-side edge of all public roads. A ball which comes to rest on or across a public road is out of bounds even though it may lie on another part of the course.

Dropping Zones: *Holes #9 and #14* – If a ball is in the Red Penalty Area of Holes #9 and #14 between the two blue stakes on either end of the bunker left of the green, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball has not been found came to rest in the Penalty Area, the player has these relief options, each for one penalty stroke:

- Proceed under Rule 17.1d; or
- As an extra option, drop the original ball or another ball in the Dropping Zone (DZ) short of the left greenside bunker. All dropping zones for this competition are marked by a VSGA dropping zone sign. These Dropping Zones are for a ball entering **between the two blue stakes only.**

Caddies: Players may have a caddie, but he/she must meet the same age requirements for the tournament as the player.

Transportation: Model Local Rule G-6 is in effect. During a round, a player or caddie must not ride on any form of motorized transportation except as authorized by the Committee. The player gets the general penalty for each hole during which there is a breach of this Local Rule. If the breach occurs between the play of two holes, it applies to the next hole.

Pace of Play: Please refer to the VSGA Standard Local Rules and VSGA.org for the complete pace of play policy.

Scorecard/Scoring: The digital scorecard used via the app is the unofficial scorecard. The official scorecard is the paper scorecard, which needs to be verified in the scoring area. The scoring area is located in the private room next to the banquet room.

Playoff/Ties: A sudden death playoff will be held if there is a tie for the overall champion. All other ties will be broken using the USGA scorecard playoff method.
