VSGA Last Chance Amateur Qualifying Williamsburg National Golf Club (Yorktown)

June 15, 2026

Notice to Players

(This information supplements the Championship entry and the Standard Local Rules and Terms of Competition for 2026 VSGA Championships)

FORMAT & TEE MARKERS: 18-hole stroke play. Play will be from the **Williamsburg National** tee markers.

OUT OF BOUNDS: In addition to the line between the course-side points, at ground level, of white stakes and fence posts, out of bounds is also defined by this course-side edge of all public roads. A ball which comes to rest on or across a public road defined as out of bounds is out of bounds even though it may lie on another part of the course.

PREFERRED LIES: When any part of a player's ball touches part of the general area cut to fairway height or less, the player may take free relief once by placing the original ball or another ball in and playing it from this relief area.

- Size of the Relief Area -1 Club length.
- Limits on Location of Relief Area - Not near the hole than the reference point and must be in the general area.

RELIEF FROM SEAMS OF CUT TURF: Model Local Rule F-7 is in effect. If a player's ball lies in or touches a seam of cut turf or a seam interferes with the player's area of intended swing:

- Ball in General Area. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b.
- Ball on Putting Green. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1d.
- **But interference does not exist if the seam only interferes with the player's stance.**

GROUND UNDER REPAIR: Piles of dirt and mulch from areas where trees have been removed are deemed ground under repair. Consult a referee or play a second ball if there are any questions.

SCORECARDS & SCORING AREA: The digital scorecard used via the Golf Genius app is the unofficial scorecard. The official scorecard is the paper scorecard which needs to be verified in the scoring area which will be in the private room behind the clubhouse and near the pro shop.

TIES/PLAYOFF: There are five (5) spots available for the VSGA Amateur Championship. A sudden death playoff to determine the final spot will be held immediately after the completion of play. If players are not present the winner of the playoff will be decided using a random method.

CADDIES/TRANSPORTATION: Players may have a caddie and caddies may ride in carts only if there is a seat available. Spectators (outside influences) may ride in carts if there is a seat available.
