NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This information supplements the Championship entry and the Standard Local Rules and Terms of Competition for 2026 VSGA Championships)

Tee Markers:

65+ Division: **White** VSGA tees | 70+ Division: **Green** VSGA tees | 75+ Division: **Gold** VSGA tees

Format/Scoring: Two 18-hole four-ball stroke play competition. The score to count must be clearly identified as the score of the individual partner who made that score. If this is not done, the side is disqualified.

Out of Bounds: Out of bounds is defined by the line between the course-side points, at ground level, of white stakes and fence posts, out of bounds is also defined by the course-side edge of all public roads. A ball which comes to rest on or across a public road defined as out of bounds is out of bounds even though it may lie on another part of the course.

Hole #10: The out of bounds stakes left of Hole #10 define OB during play of Hole #10 only. During play of any other hole, the stakes are obstructions.

Hole #16: The out of bounds stakes left of Hole #16 define OB during play of Hole #16 only. During play of any other hole, the stakes are obstructions.

Ground Under Repair:

No Play Zones: The nursery area between *Hole #14 and Hole #16* is a No Play Zone. When a ball is in a no play zone, the ball **must not** be played as it lies and relief must be taken from interference (lie of ball, stance, or swing) from the no play zone under Rule 16.1b.

Caddies/Transportation: Players may have a caddie and caddies may ride in carts only if there is a seat available. Spectators (outside influence) may ride in carts if there is a seat available.

Scoring: The digital scorecard used via the Golf Genius app is the unofficial scorecard. The official scorecard is the paper scorecard which needs to be verified in the scoring area (located on the Patio behind 18 green).

Playoff/Ties: A sudden death playoff will be held if there is a tie for the Champion. The holes to be used will be announced prior to the completion of play. Ties for all other prizes will be broken using the USGA scorecard playoff method (Holes 10-18, Holes 13-18, Holes 16-18, Hole 18, random method).

Prizes: Prizes will be awarded to the overall champion and top finishers.
