NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This information supplements the Championship entry and the Standard Local Rules and Terms of Competition for 2024 VSGA Championships)



FORMAT/TEE MARKERS: 18-hole stroke play. Play will be from the **Red** tees.

PREFERRED LIES: When a player's ball lies in a part of the general area cut to fairway height or less, the player may take free relief once by placing the original ball or another ball in and playing it from this relief area:

Reference Point: Spot of the original ball.

Size of Relief Area Measured from Reference Point: **one club length**

from the reference point, but with these limits:

Limits on Location of Relief Area:

- Must not be nearer the hole than the reference point, and
- Must be in the general area.

In proceeding under this Local Rule, the player must choose a spot to place the ball and use the procedures for replacing a ball under Rules 14.2b(2) and 14.2e.

OUT OF BOUNDS: Out of bounds is defined by white lines and fence posts. When white lines are present, they define the margin of the out of bounds and the stakes identify. The margin is determined by the course-side edge of the white line and the inside edge at ground level of fence posts.

MATERIAL PILED FOR REMOVAL: Any material piled for removal, including the sand and soil pile behind the 4th green, are ground under repair. Players may take free relief in accordance with Rule 16.1.

MAINTENANCE AREA: The maintenance area, adjacent parking lot, and other equipment are immovable obstructions. Players may take free relief in accordance with Rule 16.1.

SCORING: The digital scorecard used via the Golf Genius app is the unofficial scorecard. The official scorecard is the paper scorecard which needs to be verified in the scoring area (located next to the scoreboard off of the 18th green).

CADDIES/TRANSPORTATION: Players may have a caddie and caddies may ride in carts only if there is a seat available. Spectators (outside influences) may ride in carts if there is a seat available.

PACE OF PLAY: Please refer to the VSGA Standard Local Rules, and VSGA.org for the complete pace of play policy.

TIES/PLAYOFF: There are **three (3)** spots available for the VSGA Senior Amateur Championship and **one (1)** spot available for the Senior Open of Virginia. A sudden death playoff to determine the final spot and three (3) alternate spots for both the VSGA Senior Amateur Championship and Senior Open of Virginia will be held immediately after the completion of play. If players are not present the winner of the playoff will be decided using a random method.
