**Notice to Players**

*(This information supplements the Championship entry and the Standard Local Rules and Terms of Competition for 2024 VSGA Championships.)*



**FORMAT/TEE MARKERS:** Four (4) 9-hole stipulated rounds. Boys will play from the BLUE tee markers.

**Course Rotation:** Holes #1 - #9: Monocan; Holes #10 - #18: Shamokin.

**CADDIES:** Players in 9-, 18-, 36 hole, and junior championships are required to walk. Players competing in 18 or 36-hole events may have a caddie, but that caddie must be 18 years old or younger.

**Out of Bounds:** In addition to the line between the course-side points, at ground level, of white stakes and fence posts, out of bounds is also defined by the course-side edge of all public roads. A ball which comes to rest on or across a public road defined as out of bounds is out of bounds even though it may lie on another part of the course.

**Temporary Immovable Obstructions:** Model Local Rule F-23 is in effect for greenside fans. Relief procedure may be taken on either side of the TIO.

**Dropping Zones:** If, after one attempt, during play of the below listed holes, a ball is in or it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found lies in the Yellow Penalty Area on **hole #5**, the player may:

- (i) proceed under Rule 17.1d; or
- (ii) as an additional option, drop the original ball or another ball, under penalty of one stroke, in the designated Dropping Zone (marked "DZ")

#5: located on the most forward tee.

**Pace of Play:** Please refer to the official scorecard, VSGA Standard Local Rules, and VSGA.org for the complete pace of play policy.

**Scorecards/Scoring Area:** The digital scorecard used via the app is the unofficial scorecard. The official scorecard is the paper scorecard which needs to be verified in the scoring area. The scoring area is defined by the patio area near #18 green. A competitor is deemed to have left the scoring area when he/she has left the property. The scorecard is deemed returned once the player has left the scoring area.

**TIES/PLAYOFFS:** A sudden death playoff will be held if there is a tie for the Overall Boy Champion. Any ties for player rankings points will be split.
