

## VSGA Four-Ball/Senior Four-Ball Qualifying Draper Valley Golf Club May 7, 2024

## NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This information supplements the Championship entry and the Standard Local Rules and Terms of Competition for 2024 VSGA Championships.)

FORMAT/TEE MARKERS: 18 -hole four-ball stroke play.

- Four-Ball Qualifying: BLUE tee markers
- Senior Four-Ball Qualifying: WHITE tee markers

OUT OF BOUNDS: In addition to the line between the course-side points, at ground level, of white stakes and fence posts, out of bounds is also defined by this course-side edge of all ashphalt surfaces (entrance road, parking lot, maintenance building). A ball which comes to rest on or across a public road defined as out of bounds is out of bounds even though it may lie on another part of the course.

PENALTY AREA- Hole \#7: The outside edge of the bulkhead behind the bunker defines the edge of the penalty area.

SCORING: The score to count must be clearly identified as the score of the individual partner who made that score. If this is not done, the side is disqualified.

The digital scorecard used via the Golf Genius app is the unofficial scorecard. The official scorecard is the paper scorecard which needs to be verified in the scoring area.

CADDIES/TRANSPORTATION: Players may have a caddie and caddies may ride in carts only if there is a seat available. Spectators (outside agencies) may ride is carts if there is a seat available.

PACE OF PLAY: Please refer to the VSGA Standard Local Rules, and VSGA.org for the complete pace of play policy.

TIES/PLAYOFFS: There are six (6) spots available in the Four-Ball qualifier and three (3) spots available in the Senior Four-Ball qualifier. A sudden death playoff to determine the final spot and two (2) alternate spots for both the Four-Ball and Senior Four-Ball will be held immediately after the completion of play. If sides are not present the winner of the playoff will be decided by a random method.
