



101st VSGA Women's Amateur Championship
Roanoke Country Club (Redbud/Dogwood)
July 21-23, 2026

NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This information supplements the Championship entry and the Standard Local Rules and Terms of Competition for 2026 VSGA Championships)

TEE MARKERS: All play will be from the RED VSGA tee markers.

FORMAT: 18-hole stroke play qualifying. 43 players will make match play and the low 16 scores will make up the Championship Flight. All remaining players will be flighted and seeded by qualifying score into flights of eight.

TIES/PLAYOFF: A sudden death playoff will be held if there is a tie for the final match play spot in the Championship Flight. Ties for match play seeding will be settled by a blind draw except that places of those participating in the playoff to determine the final spot(s) in the championship flight will be determined by performance in the playoff.

OUT OF BOUNDS: In addition to the line between the course-side points, at ground level, of white stakes, fence posts, chain link fence, when white stakes and fences posts are present together (i.e. left of #18), the white stakes define out of bounds.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR – Areas with netting: Any areas of the golf course that have netting laying on top of the ground are deemed ground under repair. Free relief can be taken from these areas under Rule 16.1.

UNPLAYABLE BALL - DROPPING ZONES: *Holes #3 & #6* - If the player treats their ball that lies between the blue dots/blue stakes unplayable because of interference with the fence which defines out of bounds, the player may under penalty of one stroke:

- a. proceed under Rule 19; or
- b. as an additional option, drop a ball or another ball in the designated Dropping Zone closest to where the ball lies.

OBSTRUCTIONS - DROPPING ZONES: *Holes #3 & #6* - As an additional option when taking relief under Rule 16.1 for the cart path marked by blue dots/stakes, players may use a dropping zone provided as an additional option without penalty. If using a dropping zone, the player must go to the dropping zone that is closest to them.

SCORING: The digital scorecard used via the Golf Genius app is the unofficial scorecard. The official scorecard is the paper scorecard which needs to be verified in the scoring area (outside the Pro Shop).
