

Notice to Cometitors

(This information supplements the Championship entry and the Standard Local Rules and Terms of Competition for 2024 VSGA Championships)

Tee Markers

All play will be from the following tee markers:

Males age 12 and under: VSGA Gold Males age 13-15: VSGA Green Males age 16-49: VSGA Red Males age 50-64: VSGA White Males age 65 and over: VSGA Green

Females age 12 and under: VSGA Gold Females age 13-15: VSGA Gold Females age 16-49 and a H.I. of 9.9 or less: VSGA Green Females age 16-49 and a H.I. of 10.0 or greater: VSGA Gold Females age 50 and older: VSGA Gold

<u>Format</u>

Two-person captain's choice. Both players tee off, select the best shot, and each hits the next shot from that spot and subsequently selected spots until the ball is holed.

Where to play

The ball chosen for play may be lifted, cleaned and placed within <u>one club length</u> of its original position, not nearer the hole, in a like condition (i.e. fairway to fairway, rough to rough, and must remain within bunker or hazard), except on the putting green, where it must be placed within <u>one putter head</u> of the original position. The team may play in whatever order they decide.

Restriction of Standing Behind Player

Rule 10.2b(4) is not in effect for this competition.

Max Score

All teams will play the "double par" max rule. If a team reaches double par of the hole they are playing, they are encouraged to pick up.

Out of Bounds

Out of bounds is defined by the inside edge at ground level of white stakes and silt fence posts. In addition, white lines painted on the ground define out of bounds. The road behind #11 defines out of bounds and is defined by the inside edge of the road.

Prizes

Prizes will be awarded to the overall champion and additional places in the 12 and under (three places), 13-15 (three places), 16-29 (three places), 30 and over (three places).

<u>Ties</u>

Ties for all prizes will be broken using the USGA scorecard playoff method (holes 10-18, holes 13-18, holes 16-18, hole 18, flip of a coin).

Scorcards/Scoring Area

The digital scorecard used via the app is the unofficial scorecard. The official scorecard is the paper scorecard which needs to be verified in the scroring area. The scoring area is defined by the Spring Creek property. A competitor is deemed to have left the scoring area when he/she has left the Spring Creek property.
