



13th VSGA Super Senior Four-Ball Championship Blacksburg Country Club

Notice to Players

(This information supplements the Championship entry and the Standard Local Rules and Terms of Competition for 2025 VSGA Championships)

TEE MARKERS:

65+ Division : RED VSGA tee markers 70+ Division: WHITE VSGA tee markers 75+ Division: GOLD VSGA tee markers

FORMAT: Two 18-hole four-ball stroke play competition. The score to count must be clearly identified as the score of the individual partner who made that score. If this is not done, the side is disqualified.

OUT OF BOUNDS: In addition to the line between the course-side points, at ground level, of white stakes and fence posts, out of bounds is also defined by the course side edge of all public roads and the parking lot. A ball which comes to rest on or across a public road defined as out of bounds is out of bounds even though it may lie on another part of the course.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR: The drain on the left side of hole #4 is ground under repair. Free releif is allowed under rule 16.1a.

WRONG PUTTING GREEN: Hole #9 – The practice putting green behind the green is a wrong putting green. Relief in accordance with Rule 13.1f.

NO PLAY ZONES - ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITION: Hole #12 - The flower bed behind the putting green is a No Play Zone. Relief must be taken from interference (lie of ball, stance, or swing) from the no play zone under Rule 16.1f.

PACE OF PLAY: Please refer to the VSGA Standard Local Rules, and VSGA.org for the complete pace of play policy.

SCORECARDS/SCORING AREA: The digital scorecard used via the app is the unofficial scorecard. The official scorecard is the paper scorecard which needs to be verified in the scoring area. The scoring area is defined by the patio area near #10 tee. A competitor is deemed to have left the scoring area when he/she has left the property. The scorecard is deemed returned once the player has left the scoring area.

TIES/PLAYOFF: A sudden death playoff will be held if there is a tie for the Champion in any division and the holes to be used will be announced prior to the completion of play. All other ties will be broken using the USGA scorecard method will be used (holes 10-18, holes 13-18, holes 16-18, hole 18, random method).

PRIZES: Gross prizes will be awarded to the champions and top finishers in each division.
