NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This information supplements the Championship entry and the Standard Local Rules and Terms of Competition for 2024 VSGA Championships)

FORMAT/TEE MARKERS: 18-hole stroke play each day. Four (4) 9-hole stipulated rounds. Play for the Boys division will be from the **BLACK** tees. Play for the Girls Division will be from the **WHITE** tees.

OUT OF BOUNDS: In addition to the line between the course-side points, at ground level, of white stakes and fence posts, out of bounds is also defined by this course side edge of all public roads and the parking lot. A ball which comes to rest on or across a public road defined as out of bounds is out of bounds even though it may lie on another part of the course.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR: Any areas defined with white lines is deemed ground under repair. All sand piled areas in the fairways are deemed to be ground under repair. Specifically on Hole #10, the soil/dirt areas in the fairway are deemed ground under repair. Players may take relief under rule 16.1.

PREFERRED LIES: If a player's ball lies in any part of the general area; the player may take free relief once by lifting, cleaning, and placing the original ball or another ball in the relief area. The relief area is **one club length** from the spot of the original ball, but with these limits: Must not be replaced nearer the hole than the reference point, and must be in the General Area. In proceeding under this Local Rule, the player must choose a spot to place the ball and use the procedures for replacing a ball under Rules 14.2b(2) and 14.2e.

CADDIES/TRANSPORTATION: Players may have a caddie as long as the caddie meets the same age eligibility requirements as the player.

PACE OF PLAY: Please refer to the VSGA Standard Local Rules, and VSGA.org for the complete pace of play policy.

SCORECARDS/SCORING AREA: The digital scorecard used via the app is the unofficial scorecard. The official scorecard is the paper scorecard which needs to be verified in the scoring area. Scoring will be done in the grill area. The scoring area is defined as the golf course property. A competitor is deemed to have left the scoring area when he/she has left the golf course. The scorecard is deemed returned once the player has left the scoring area.

TIES/PLAYOFF: A sudden death playoff will be held if there is a tie for the Overall Boy and/or Girl. Any ties for player rankings points will be split.

The top five players and ties from the boys' division will earn an exemption into the 2024 VSGA Junior Stroke Play Championship.
