



Junior Golf Circuit 36-Hole Event Bide-A-Wee Golf Course March 22-23, 2025

NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This information supplements the Championship entry and the Standard Local Rules and Terms of Competition for 2025 VSGA Championships)

Format/Tee Markers:

18-hole stroke play each day. Four (4) 9-hole stipulated rounds. Play for the Boys division will be from the GOLD tees. Play for the Girls Division will be from the WHITE tees.

Out of Bounds:

In addition to the line between the course-side points, at ground level, of white stakes and fence posts, out of bounds is also defined by this course-side edge of all public roads and the parking lot. A ball which comes to rest on or across a public road defined as out of bounds is out of bounds even though it may lie on another part of the course.

<u>Ground Under Repair:</u> Circular areas of dirt where a tree has been removed is ground under repair. If there are any questions, consult a rules official or play two balls.

Penalty Areas: The waterside edge of the bulkhead on hole #3 defines the edge of the penalty area.

<u>Dropping Zone - Hole #12</u>: If it is known or virtually certain that a ball not found has come to rest in the penalty area, the player may proceed under Rule 17; or as an additional option, drop a ball, under penalty of one stroke, in the Dropping Zone which is defined as the closely mown area of the most forward tee.

<u>Wrong Green - Holes #2 and #9:</u> The practice putting greens and chipping greens are wrong greens and relief is mandatory for any interference. Players must take relief in accordance with Rule 13.1f for lie of the ball, area of intended stance, and area of intended swing.

Caddies/Transportation:

Players must walk. Players may have a caddie as long as the caddie meets the same age eligibility requirements as the player.

<u>Pace of Play:</u> Please refer to the VSGA Standard Local Rules, and VSGA.org for the complete pace of play policy.

Scorecards/Scoring Area:

The digital scorecard used via the app is the unofficial scorecard. The official scorecard is the paper scorecard which needs to be verified in the scoring area. The scoring area is located inside the clubhouse in the Curtis Strange conference room. A competitor is deemed to have left the scoring area when he/she has left the property. The scorecard is deemed returned once the player has left the scoring area.

<u>Ties/Playoff:</u> A sudden-death playoff will be held if there is a tie for the Overall Boy and/or Girl. Any ties for player rankings points will be split.
