**NOTICE TO PLAYERS**

Play will be in accordance with USGA Rules, the VSGA Intercollegiate Conditions of the Competition, the NCAA Local Rules and Conditions of Competition (QR Code below), and the following local rules. Penalty for breach of a local rule is two strokes, unless otherwise noted.

**Tee Markers:** All play will be from the Green VSGA tee markers.

**Format:** 36-hole individual stroke play competition.

**One-Ball Rule:** The one-ball rule is not in effect for this competition.

**Transportation:** Players must walk at all times, once the round has started and until the round is over. Players may take their carts back to the clubhouse once play has been completed.

**Out of Bounds:** In addition to the line between the course-side points, at ground level, of white stakes and fence posts, out of bounds is also defined by the course-side edge of all public roads. A ball which comes to rest on or across a public road defined as out of bounds is out of bounds even though it may lie on another part of the course.

**Dropping Zone – Penalty Areas:** If a ball is in or it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found lies in the penalty area, the player may:

- Proceed under Rule 17.1d or
- as an additional option, drop a ball, under penalty of one stroke, in the dropping zone.
  - Hole #4: The most forward tee
  - Hole #8: At the end of the fairway
  - Hole #11: The most forward tee
  - Hole #18: At the end of the fairway

**Dropping Zone – Ground Under Repair – Hole #12:** As an additional option when taking relief under Rule 16.1 from the ground under repair, players may use a dropping zone provided as an additional option without penalty. If using a dropping zone, the player must go to the dropping zone that is indicated by the white line.

**Advice:** Model Local Rule H-2 is in effect for this competition. Each team may appoint two people (in addition to the persons from whom advice may be asked under that Rule) who may give advice to members of that team. These people must be identified to the Committee before giving advice.

**Pace of Play:** Please refer to the official scorecard, VSGA Standard Local Rules, and VSGA.org for the complete pace of play policy.

**Scorecards/Scoring Area:** The digital scorecard used via the app is the unofficial scorecard. The official scorecard is the paper scorecard, which needs to be verified in the scoring area. The scoring area is located inside the clubhouse near the pro shop.
