



VSGA Senior & Super Senior Multi-Format Team Championship Lakeside Park club September 23-24

NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This information supplements the Championship entry and the Standard Local Rules and Terms of Competition for 2025 VSGA Championships)

<u>Tee Markers:</u> Senior Division: Red VSGA tee markers

Super Senior Division: Gold VSGA tee markers

<u>Format:</u> Modified Foursomes (modified alternate shot): Both players play from the teeing area, one of the tee shots is selected, and players alternate shots from there until the ball is holed. Example: Player A's tee shot is selected, player B plays next, then A, and so on until the ball is holed.

<u>Restriction on Caddie/Partner Standing Behind Player:</u> Rule 10.2b(4) does not apply during round one (scramble format) only.

<u>Out of Bounds:</u> In addition to the line between the course-side points, at ground level, of white stakes and fence posts, out of bounds is also defined by the course-side edge of all public roads and club parking lot. A ball which comes to rest on or across a public road defined as out of bounds is out of bounds even though it may lie on another part of the course.

<u>Temporary Immovable Obstructions:</u> Model Local Rule F-23 is in effect for greenside fans. Relief procedure may be taken on either side of the TIO.

<u>Ground Under Repair:</u> All areas of newly laid sod on the course are to be treated as Ground Under Repair (GUR) under Rule 16.1.

Faint/Old Paint Lines: Disregard any faded/faint red paint lines.

<u>Scoring:</u> The digital scorecard used via the Golf Genius app is the unofficial scorecard. The official scorecard is the paper scorecard, which needs to be verified in the scoring area. The scoring area will be in the VSGA tent outside the pro shop.

Pace of Play: Please refer to the VSGA Standard Local Rules, and VSGA.org for the complete pace of play policy.

<u>Prizes:</u> Prizes will be awarded to the overall champions and top finishers in each flight. A tie for the overall champions will be decided by a sudden-death playoff using the modified foursomes format. Ties for all other prizes will be broken using the USGA scorecard playoff method (Holes 10-18, Holes 13-18, Holes 16-18, Hole 18, random method).
