NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This information supplements the Championship entry and the Standard Local Rules and Terms of Competition for 2025 VSGA Championships)

Tee Markers: Boys: Green VSGA tees | Girls: Red VSGA tees

Format: 18-hole stroke play each day. Each round will be played as four (4) nine-hole rounds.

Caddies/Transportation: Players may have a caddie, but he/she must meet the same age requirements for the tournament as the player. Players and caddies must walk at all times.

Yellow Dropping Areas: Yellow painted circled dropping zone areas have no status for this competition.

Out of Bounds: In addition to the line between the course-side points, at ground level, of white stakes and fence posts, out of bounds is also defined by the course-side edge of all public roads and the parking lot. A ball which comes to rest on or across a public road defined as out of bounds is out of bounds even though it may lie on another part of the course.

Pace of Play: Please refer to the official scorecard, VSGA Standard Local Rules (QR code below), and VSGA.org for the complete pace of play policy.

Scorecards/Scoring Area: The digital scorecard used via the app is the unofficial scorecard. The official scorecard is the paper scorecard, which needs to be verified in the scoring area. Scoring will be done in the upstairs area of the grill.

Playoff/Ties: A sudden-death playoff will be held if there is a tie for the Overall Boy and/or Girl. Any ties for player rankings points will be split.

The top five players and ties from the boys' division will earn an exemption into the 2026 VSGA Junior Stroke Play Championship.
