Tee Markers:

• 65+ Championship: GREEN VSGA tee markers

• 70+ Championship: WHITE VSGA tee markers

• 75+ Division: GOLD VSGA tee markers

<u>Format/Scoring</u>: 36-hole stroke play. The digital scorecard used via the Golf Genius app is the unofficial scorecard. The official scorecard is the paper scorecard, which needs to be verified in the scoring area. Scoring will be located behind the 18th green.

<u>Playoff/Ties</u>: A sudden-death playoff will be held if there is a tie for the Champion of each division. Ties for all other prizes will be broken using the USGA scorecard playoff method (holes 10-18, holes 13-18, holes 16-18, hole 18, flip of a coin).

Out of Bounds: In addition to the course-side points, at ground level, of white stakes, out of bounds is also defined by:

• the course-side edge of the speed bump and curbing surrounding the club parking lot;

Roads and fence posts do not define out of bounds.

Dropping Zone: Hole #7, #11 (for greenside penalty area only) & #12

- i. proceed under Rule 17.1d; or
- ii. as an additional option, drop a ball, under penalty of one stroke, in the dropping zone.

<u>Wrong Putting Green</u>: The nursery green on hole #2 is deemed a wrong putting green, and relief is mandatory under Rule 13.1f.

<u>Temporary Immovable Obstructions:</u> Modal Local Rule F-23 is in effect. Any air-circulation fans on the course are temporary immovable obstructions. Relief procedure may be taken on either side of the TIO.

<u>Caddies/Transportation</u>: Players may have a caddie and caddies may ride in carts only if there is a seat available. Spectators (outside influence) may ride in carts if there is a seat available.
