Notice to Players

(This information supplements the Championship entry and the Standard Local Rules and Terms of Competition for 2026 VSGA Championships)

FORMAT & TEE MARKERS: 36-hole stroke play competition.

- 65+ Division: Green VSGA tee markers
- 70+ Division: Gold VSGA tee markers
- 75+ Division: Red VSGA tee markers

TIES/PLAYOFF: A sudden-death playoff will be held if there is a tie for the Champion of each division. Ties for all other prizes will be broken using the USGA scorecard playoff method.

OUT OF BOUNDS: In addition to the line between the course-side points, at ground level, of white stakes and fence posts, out of bounds is also defined by this course side edge of all public roads. A ball which comes to rest on or across a public road defined as out of bounds is out of bounds even though it may lie on another part of the course.

PENALTY AREAS – DROPPING ZONES: If a ball is in or it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found is in the penalty area, the player may proceed under Rule 17.1d, or as an additional option, drop a ball, under penalty of one stroke, in the dropping zone:

- **Hole #4:** The most forward tee.
- **Hole #8:** At the end of the fairway.
- **Hole #11:** The most forward tee.
- **Hole #18:** At the end of the fairway.

TEMPORARY IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS: Model Local Rule F-23 is in effect for greenside fans. Relief procedure may be taken on either side of the TIO.

SCORECARDS & SCORING AREA: The digital scorecard used via the Golf Genius app is the unofficial scorecard. The official scorecard is the paper scorecard which needs to be verified in the scoring area which will be inside in the main entrance room.

CADDIES/TRANSPORTATION: Players may have a caddie, and caddies may ride in carts only if there is a seat available. Spectators (outside influences) may ride in carts if there is a seat available.

PACE OF PLAY: Please refer to the VSGA Standard Local Rules, and VSGA.org for the complete pace of play policy.
